What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\bullet}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\circ}$ : 1 skein each of 319 Cherry Red A, 316 Soft White B, and 385 Royal C

Large can $15^{\prime \prime}(38 \mathrm{~cm})$ diameter, small can $3^{\prime \prime}(7.5 \mathrm{~cm})$ diameter, craft glue, tape, scissors

## All-American Cans

Anyone can get in on the fun of decorating with true American spirit! Simply wrap and glue your way to having patriotic cans to set the stage for your next Memorial Day or 4th of July gettogether. For other occasions, change up the colors to fit the scene.

## Notes

1. The larger diameter can is the same size as the average large coffee can. The smaller diameter can is the same size as the average soup can.
2. Be sure to clean, dry and remove any labels from the cans. Be careful to file any sharp edges on can openings.

## LARGE CAN

1. Spread a generous amount of craft glue around the lower section of the can. Pull a length of color $\mathbf{A}$ from the skein. Cut a small piece of tape and secure the end of A to the bottom of can.
2. Wrap $\mathbf{A}$ around can, being sure to keep each strand snug against the previously wrapped strand. Wrap around can 4 times. Cut A, securing end by tucking under previously wrapped strands.
3. Pull a length of color $\mathbf{B}$ from the skein. Cut a small piece of tape and secure end of $\mathbf{B}$ to can wherer $\mathbf{A}$ is secured. Wrap B around can 3 times. Cut B, securing end by tucking under previously wrapped strands.
4. Pull a length of color $\mathbf{C}$ from the skein. Cut a small piece of tape and secure end of $\mathbf{C}$ to can wear $\mathbf{B}$ is secured. Wrap $\mathbf{C}$ around can 4 times. Cut $\mathbf{C}$, securing end by tucking under previously wrapped strands.
5. Pull a length of color $\mathbf{B}$ from the skein. Cut a small piece of tape and secure end of $\mathbf{B}$ to can wear $\mathbf{C}$ is secured. Wrap B around can 4 times. Cut B, securing end by tucking under previously wrapped strands.
6. Begin alternating $\mathbf{A}$ and $\mathbf{B}$, continuing to spread glue on can, until only $11 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ of can remains unwrapped, ending by wrapping with $\mathbf{A}$.
7. Pull a length of color B from the skein. Cut a small piece of tape and secure end of $\mathbf{B}$ to can wear $\mathbf{A}$ is secured. Wrap B around can 4 times. Cut B, securing end by tucking under previously wrapped strands.
8. Pull a length of color $\mathbf{C}$ from the skein. Cut a small piece of tape and secure end of $\mathbf{C}$ to can wear $\mathbf{B}$ is secured. Wrap $\mathbf{C}$ around can 4 times. Cut $\mathbf{C}$, securing end by tucking under previously wrapped strands.
9. Pull a length of color B from the skein. Cut a small piece of tape and secure end of $\mathbf{B}$ to can wear $\mathbf{C}$ is secured. Wrap B around can 3 times. Cut $\mathbf{B}$, securing end by tucking under previously wrapped strands.
10. Pull a length of color $\mathbf{A}$ from the skein. Cut a small piece of tape and secure end of $\mathbf{A}$ to can wear $\mathbf{B}$ is secured. Wrap $\mathbf{A}$ around can 4 times. Cut $\mathbf{A}$, securing end by tucking under previously wrapped strands.

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## SMALL CAN

1. Spread a generous amount of craft glue around the lower section of the can. Pull a length of color $\mathbf{A}$ from the skein. Cut a small piece of tape and secure the end of A to the bottom of can.
2. Wrap A around can, being sure to keep each strand snug against the previously wrapped strand. Wrap around can 4 times. Cut A, securing end by tucking under previously wrapped strands.
3. Pull a length of color B from the skein. Cut a small piece of tape and secure end of $\mathbf{B}$ to can wear $\mathbf{C}$ is secured. Wrap B around can and begin alternating $\mathbf{A}$ and B, continuing to spread glue on can, unti only $3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ of can remains unwrapped, ending by wrapping with $\mathbf{A}$.
4. Pull a length of color $\mathbf{B}$ from the skein. Cut a small piece of tape and secure end of $\mathbf{B}$ to can wear $\mathbf{A}$ is secured. Wrap B around can 3 times. Cut B, securing end by tucking under previously wrapped strands.
5. Pull a length of color $\mathbf{C}$ from the skein. Cut a small piece of tape and secure end
of $\mathbf{C}$ to can wear $\mathbf{B}$ is secured. Wrap $\mathbf{C}$ around can 3 times. Cut $\mathbf{C}$, securing end by tucking under previously wrapped strands.
6. Pull a length of color B from the skein. Cut a small piece of tape and secure end of $\mathbf{B}$ to can wear $\mathbf{C}$ is secured. Wrap B around can 3 times. Cut $\mathbf{B}$, securing end by tucking under previously wrapped strands.
