What you will need:

RED HEART® Fur™: 220 Lemon Drop, 620 Lime, 710 Tulip Pink, 501 Aqua Blue

Scissors, white foam core board, sharp pencil, craft knife, craft glue, 3 white chenille stems, pink craft felt, white cardstock, 1 pair google

GAUGE: Gauge is not critical for this project.

BUY YARN



RED HEART® Fur™, Art. E831 available in 3.5 oz (100 g), 11 yd (10 m) balls




Funny Bunny Faces

These bunnies are ready to hop into spring! Easy to make, they'll help chase the winter blues away with their bright colors.

BUNNY

1: Print pattern and cut out. Trace onto white foam core board. Cut out with craft knife using adult supervision if needed.



2: Using a pencil, poke 2 holes in center of bunny face.



3: Glue one end of yarn to bunny head.



4: Wind and glue yarn around ear, gluing as needed to hold yarn in place.



5: Continue to wind and glue yarn around the second ear.

6: Wind and glue yarn around the bunny face, continuing to glue as needed to hold yarn in place.



7: Continue to wind and glue until the entire bunny face is covered with yarn.



8: Using scissors, trim yarn tail. Glue yarn tail to bunny to secure. Allow to dry.



9: Push one chenille stem through punched holes.



10: Place two additional chenille stems in center of first stem and twist all stems together.



11: Using scissors and white cardstock, cut out eyes and nose. Using scissors and pink craft felt, cut out two hearts for eyes.



12: Glue nose to center of chenille stem whiskers. Glue pink hearts to white cardstock eyes, then glue one google eye onto the center of each heart. Allow to dry.


