What you will need:

RED HEART* Pomp-a-Doodle™: 2 balls each 9314 Thunder A, 9356 Grape B or colors of choice

- 16" (41 cm) Straw wreath
- Greening pins
- 4" (10 cm) or 5" (12.7 cm) wood letters (BOO or word of choice)
- Orange acrylic paint and paint brush
- 1½" (3.8 cm) ribbon for hanging (optional)
- Seasonal bow (optional)
- Craft glue or low-temp hot glue gun



GAUGE is not important for this project.

BOO Halloween Wreath

Greet your fall visitors with a marvelous Halloween wreath! Be creative by adding a scary message and finish off with a bow. Using Pomp-a-Doodle yarn means you don't have to make each and every pompom. Yea!

WREATH Letters

Paint letters with orange paint and allow to dry. It may take more than one coat to cover.



Step 1 paint letters

Pomp-a-Doodle Chain (Make 2)

 With A and B held together make a slip knot. Using photos as a guide, make one chain stitch between each pompom continuing for entire ball until you reach the next-to-last set of pompoms. Knot the remaining rope area securely and trim excess.

Wrap Wreath

 Using the greening pins to secure, begin wrapping the first completed pompom chain around the wreath.
 Secure the end of first chain and beginning of second chain with a greening pin. Continue to wrap wreath until covered securing at the end.



Step 5 Securing

• Secure the end with a greening pin.

Notes

- Use the greening pins as needed to secure pompom chain to wreath as you wrap.
- The pompom chains should fit snug around the wreath taking care to cover completely. If you chose not to pull tight, it may require an additional ball of each color.

Letters

Using low-temp hot glue gun or craft glue, place letters in desired location and allow to dry completely.

FINISHING

Tie the hanging ribbon in a knot around the wreath. Secure the knotted end to the back size of wreath with a greening pin. If desired, place a seasonal bow as shown in photo.
