What you will need:

RED HEART[®] With Love[™] Metallic: 1 ball 8918 Red

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

8" (20.5 cm) square of foam core board, pencil, ruler, adhesive tape, utility knife, yarn needle, clear-drying craft glue, 12-gauge floral wire, small jar measuring 11/2-2" (4-5 cm) in diameter

g), 200 yd (183 m) and prints 4 oz (113 g), 152 yd (139 m) balls



Crafty Star Tree Topper

This bright star is the perfect tree topper! Simply cut star shape from foam core and wrap with festive metallic yarn. Add a coiled wire to fit a top branch and, voila! You have a star for your tree without any knitting or crocheting.


Star measures 7" (18 cm) across.


This project is appropriate for children but adult supervision is strongly recommended when cutting with a utility knife.

TREE TOPPER

Step 1: Print star template and tape lightly to foam core board. Push pencil point through template to mark each outer point and each inner corner of star. Remove template.



Step 2: With pencil and ruler, connect marked outer points and inner corners to draw the star.



Step 3: Carefully cut out star with utility knife.



Step 4: Cut a small slot at any inner corner. Catch beginning tail of yarn in this notch to secure.

Step 5: Wrap yarn around star until desired fullness is achieved. For best results, change direction of wrapping frequently. The more random the wraps, the better the star will look.



Cut yarn and thread tail on yarn needle. Weave through wraps and apply a few drops of clear-drying glue to secure.



Step 6: Cut a length of floral wire measuring 2 yds long. Leaving a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (6.5 cm) tail, wrap wire around jar.





Step 7: Push straight end of coil between yarn wraps into an inner corner.
