What you will need:

RED HEART® Scrubby Sparkle™:
2 balls 8929 Strawberry

Optional
Susan Bates® Knitting Needles:
3.75mm [US 5]

6" [15 cm] wooden letters, craft
glue or hot glue gun (with adult
supervision)

GAUGE: Gauge is not critical for
this project.

JOYful Sparkle

Wrap cardboard letters with yarn for a "JOYful" expression this holiday season! We used sparkly yarn that adds to the festive feel in your home. It's the perfect idea for the mantel, your buffet, a shelf or even your office cubicle.

NOTE

Letters are covered completely with yarn. If desired, a small piece can be knit to cover the flat top areas of the J and Y referred to as Toppers.



COVERING

1. Spread glue on flat tops and lay lengths of yarn over glue to cover completely.
2. Working in a small area at a time, spread glue along all sides of letter and wrap yarn around glued section to cover completely.
3. Continue to spread glue and yarn around sides of letters until all areas have been covered. Tuck ends under yarn and glue in place.



OPTIONAL LETTER TOPPERS (make 4)

1. Cast on 12 sts.
2. Work in Stockinette stitch until piece measures 2" [5 cm] or is large enough to cover the flat top areas of letters J and Y. Bind off.
3. Spread glue on flat tops of letters and glue Toppers in place.
4. Continue to spread glue and yarn around sides of letters until all areas have been covered. Tuck ends under yarn and glue in place.
