What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein each of 3939 Backlight A, 324 Bright Yellow B and 672 Spring Green C.

Additional Materials

Hot glue gun, glue sticks, appropriately sized twigs with branches, green floral foam (optional)



RED HEART® Super Saver®, Art. E300 available in solid color

7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); multicolor, heather and print 5 oz (141 g), 244 yd (223 m), flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins



Wrapped Twig Jewelry Holder

Take a little hike with the kids to find twigs and then transform them into colorful jewelry holders. It's a great way to organize friendship bracelets, earrings and other jewelry. Makes a great gift too! Measurement will depend on can size

Notes

This craft is designed for children, but younger children need to be supervised by an adult and an adult should always operate glue gun.

Make sure to smooth any sharp areas on the can.

WRAPPED TWIGS

Plug in and heat up glue gun.

Step 1: Using A, B or C, pull tail from center of skein, do not cut. Place a dab of hot glue on twig/stick at top of section to be covered (Photo 1). Lay tail of yarn on hot glue and let cool to harden (Photo 2).





Step 2: Begin to wrap twig in a spiral, keeping yarn neat and close together (see photos #3). Secure with a dot of glue occasionally.





Step 3: Wrap yarn to desired length (Photo 4). Cut yarn and secure with hot glue at end (Photo 5).

Step 4: Repeat as desired for other sections of twigs/sticks (Photo 6).



Step 5: Place finished twigs in yarn wrapped can (see Kid's Crafts Wrapped Storage Can LW4369) or other decorative container (Photo 7). Optional: Place a piece of green floral foam in bottom of container. Insert bottoms of trigs in foam to secure. Hang jewelry or other trinkets on twigs.
