Christmas Tassels

No time to knit or crochet? These tassels are easy-to-make. They are a good project for everyone in the family and make great gifts.

GLITTER STARFISH TASSEL

Designed By Pattie Wilkinson.

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein 321 Gold.

Materials

Pattiewack Tassel Tool (Large), Large Starfish, 20 Pony Beads, Gold Wire, Wire Cutters, Scissors and Craft Glue.

- 1. Wind yarn around the 6-inch step of the Pattiewack Tassel Tool 50 times, or until desired fullness.
- 2. Cut 6 inches of wire for the top of the tassel. Slip the wire underneath the wound yarn. Pull wire up to the top of the tassel. Twist wire to secure.

- 3. Cut another 6 inches of wire to bind the neck of the tassel. Thread wire through the neck of the tassel and through the slot in the tool. Twist wire to secure.
- 4. Cut the loops at the bottom of the tassel. Gently pull the tassel from the tool.
- 5. Tighten the wire around the neck of the tassel. Trim off excess wire and bend the ends of the wire back into the tassel.
- 6. Thread 1 bead onto each of 19 yarn-ends of the tassel. Tie each yarn-end in a knot to secure bead.
- 7. Wind yarn around the neck of the tassel until desired fullness. Tie the end of yarn in a knot. Push the knot up under the yarn.
- 8. Using photo as a guide, glue tassel onto the bottom of the starfish.
- 9. Cut 12 inches of wire. Twist the wire ends together with a bead to form a hanger.
- 10. Glue hanger to the top of the starfish.

CHRISTMAS JINGLE BELL TASSEL

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein 368 Paddy Green.

Materials

Pattiewack Tassel Tool (Large), 25 Jingle Bells, One Large Gold Bead, Wire, Wire Cutters and Scissors.

- 1. Thread 25 jingle bells onto the yarn.
- 2. Wind yarn around the 5-inch step of the Pattiewack Tassel Tool 25 times, pulling a jingle bell to the bottom of the tool each time.
- 3. Cut 6 inches of wire for the top of the tassel. Slip the wire underneath the wound yarn. Pull wire up to the top of the tassel. Twist wire to secure.
- 4. Cut another 6" of wire to bind the neck of the tassel. Thread wire through the neck of the tassel and through the slot in the tool. Twist wire to secure.
- 5. Cut the loops at the bottom of the tassel and gently pull the tassel from the tool.
- 6. Wind yarn around the neck of tassel until desired fullness. Tie yarn in a knot. Tuck knot under yarn.
- 7. Thread large bead onto the wire at the top of the tassel. Form a loop with wire and twist to create a hanger.
