What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein each 312 Black, 254 Pumpkin, and 672 Spring Green

Hot glue gun with glue sticks, artificial pumpkin, yarn needle

GAUGE: Gauge is not critical for this project.

solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); stripes, prints, multicolor and heathers 5 oz (141 g), 236 yd (215 m); and flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yd (238 m) skeins

Hand Woven Yarn Wrapped Pumpkin

No time to carve, don't want to deal with the mess? This yarn-covered pumpkin is perfect for people who don't want a real pumpkin, but love decorating for Halloween.

PUMPKIN

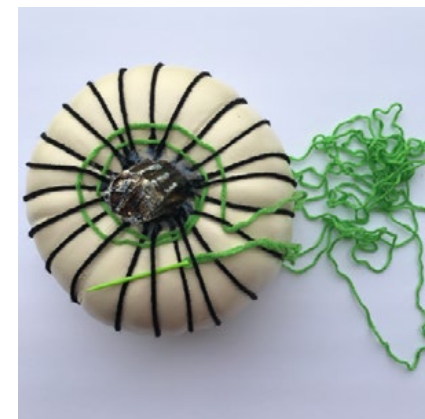
1. Cut eleven lengths of Black yarn, each 24" [61 cm] long.



2. Using a hot glue gun, glue one end of the yarn at the base of the stem. Pull it around entire pumpkin and glue it to the other side of stem. Repeat to glue lengths evenly spaced around pumpkin. Glue lengths in center of bottom to hold in place.



3. Cut six lengths of Spring Green, each 7 yds [7 m] long. Cut four lengths of Pumpkin, each 7 yds [7 m] long. With yarn needle, start weaving Spring Green yarn over and under spokes of black yarn. Keep weaving until you run out of yarn. Tuck ends underneath finished woven section or hot glue them in place.



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4. Change to Pumpkin yarn and weaving over the spokes which were previously worked under and under the spokes that previously were worked over, weave a section of Pumpkin. Continue to alternate colors and direction of the weaving until all lengths have been used and pumpkin is covered completely.



5. Cut 3 yds [3m] of Black. Using hot glue gun, glue end of the black yarn at the base of stem, covering ends and previous glue. Wrap length around stem to cover completely, tacking in place with glue.



Once all of the weaving is done, the artificial pumpkin is completely covered in yarn! You could weave different designs or leave parts of the pumpkin exposed. But it's ready to be put out for Halloween décor!
