### What you will need:

**RED HEART® Super Saver®:** 1 skein 311 White **A**

**RED HEART® Pomp-a-Doodle™:** 1 ball 9187 Bluesy **B**

Printer and printer paper, scissors, pencil, ruler, moon and star patterns, 32" x 18" (81.2 cm x 45.7 cm) white foam core board, craft knife, craft glue

**GAUGE:** Gauge is not critical for this project.

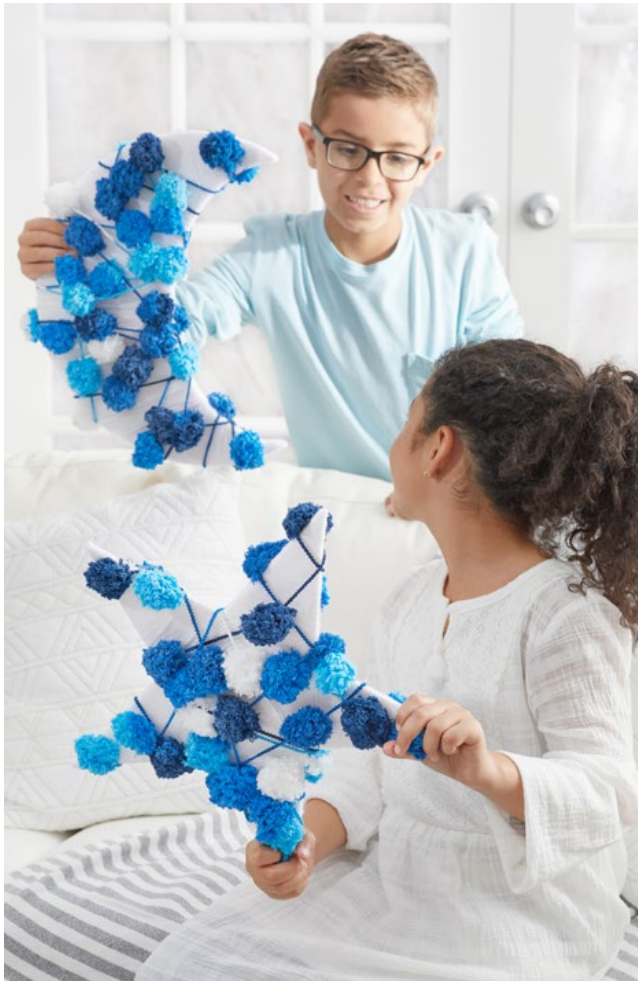


**RED HEART® Super Saver®, Art. E300** available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yds (333 m); stripes, prints, multis and heathers 5 oz (141 g), 236 yds (215 m); flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins

## Moon & Star Shapes

Cut out any shape you love and get wrapping to add a fun pop of color to any room with Pomp-a-Doodle!

**Moon and star shapes measure 15" (38 cm) tall.**

### SHAPES

**Option:** Draw shapes free hand onto foam core board.

#### Enlarge Templates

1. Print moon and star patterns onto printer paper. Be sure to select 'actual size' and check that the scale box measures 1" (2.5cm).
2. Using a ruler, draw a grid with the same number of squares as the printed grid with 3" (7.6 cm) squares on to the foam core board (if you are making more than one of the same shape, do this on a large piece of paper and use it as a pattern).
3. Number the squares across and down as on the printed grid.
4. Place the printed grid next to the grid you drew on the foam core board or large paper.
5. Starting with any square on the foam core board or large paper, draw what is in the corresponding numbered square on the printed grid.
6. Work around the entire picture until you return to the starting point and complete the picture.
7. Cut out the shape from the foam core board. If using a pattern piece, cut out the pattern and trace onto foam core board.



#### Wrap Shapes

8. Glue end of **A** to tip of the moon shape.



9. Wind **A** around the moon shape until completely covered, gluing end of yarn when covered.

10. Glue end of **B** to covered moon shape.



11. **11:** Wind **B** around the moon shape until covered as desired.



12. Repeat steps 8-12 to cover the star shape.

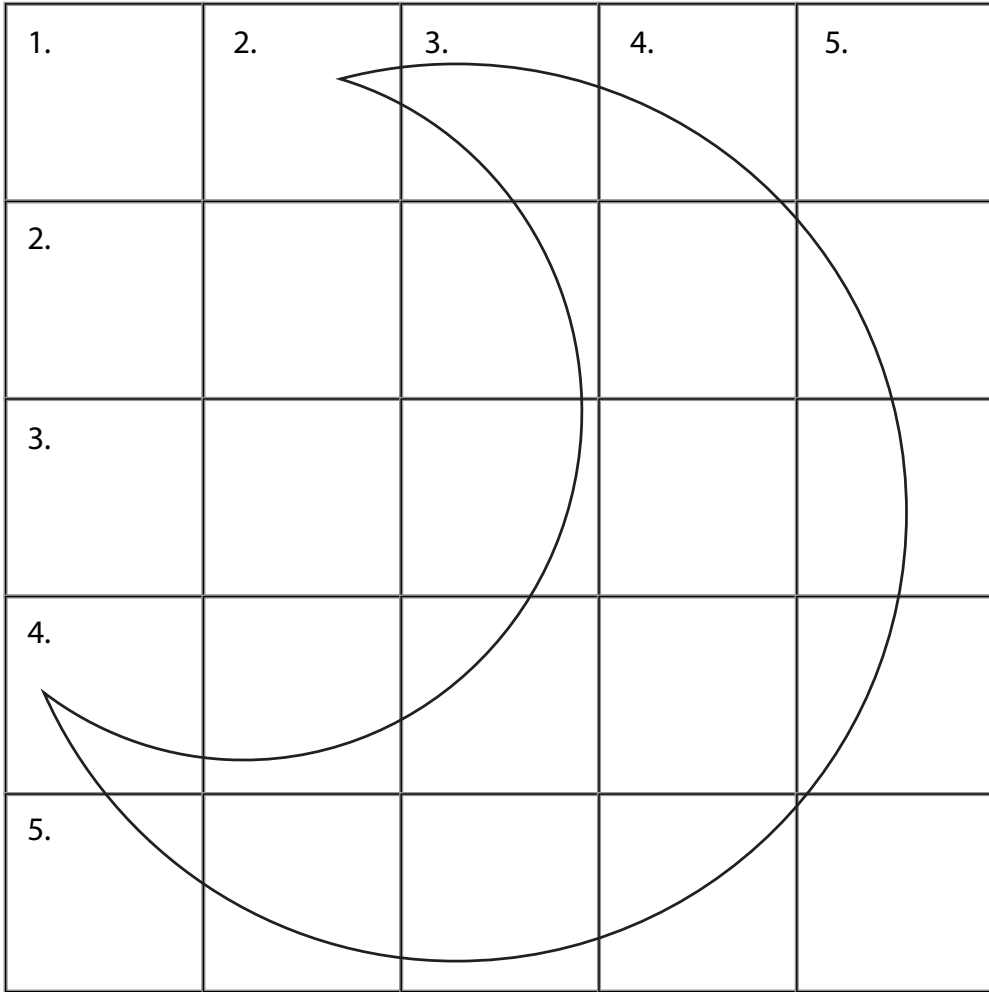


#### ABBREVIATIONS
