## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Super Saver®:** 1 skein each 512 Turqua, 3251 Flame, 672 Spring Green, and 722 Pretty 'n Pink

Craft glue, rocks, scissors

**GAUGE:** Gauge is not critical for this project.



**RED HEART® Super Saver®, Art. E300** available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yds (333 m); stripes, prints, multis and heathers 5 oz (141 g), 236 yds (215 m); flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins

# Wrapped Rocks

Wrapping rocks is a great way to play with color! It's a lot cleaner than painting them, too, so this activity is perfect for rainy days or parties.

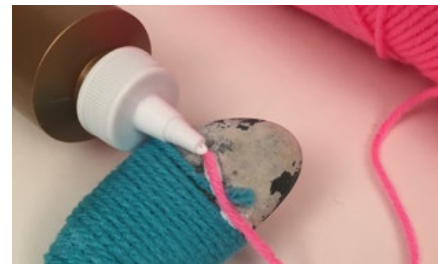
SHOP KIT

## ROCKS

1. Apply a large dot of glue to the tip of a rock. Starting with any color you'd like, arrange yarn in a spiral, covering the entire surface of the rock's edge.



2. Continue gluing and wrapping yarn around rock until ready to change to another color.  
3. Cut the yarn. Allow the glue to dry.  
4. Glue the end of the next yarn color to the rock, overlapping the last color.



5. Continue gluing and wrapping yarn around the rock until you reach the tip of the rock.  
6. Apply a large dot of glue to the tip of the rock.



7. Arrange yarn in a spiral, pressing it into the tip of the rock and covering the entire surface of the rock's edge. Cut yarn.



## Optional Designs

Using the photos as a guide, wrap yarn into a heart shape, stripes, crisscross, and other designs as desired.
