## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Fur™:** 1 ball each:  
9101 Snow **A**, 9631 Pine **B**,  
9319 Cherry **C**

- **Susan Bates® Easy-Wrap Pom-pom Maker**
- 12" [30.5 cm] Snowman foam base
- Corsage pins
- Craft glue
- Scissors
- 2 Buttons



**RED HEART® Fur™**,  
Art. E831 available  
in 3.5 oz (100 g) 11  
yd (10 m) balls



# Friendly Snowman

This snowman won't melt!  
Made with Fur yarn, this fun  
fellow is ready to add cheer  
to any room, even if the  
weather outside is frightful!

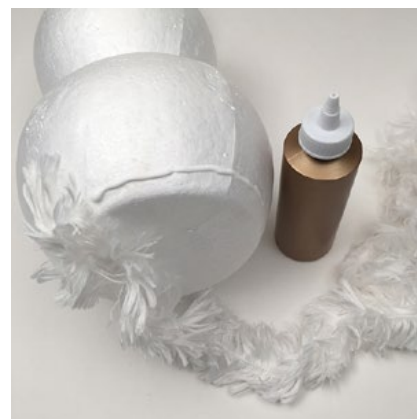
## SNOWMAN

### Steps (refer to photos):

1. Without cutting yarn from ball, pin an end of **A** yarn to the bottom edge of the snowman.



2. Apply craft glue around the edge and press yarn into glue, holding with pins as needed.



3. Wrap yarn around the snowman. Apply a band of craft adhesive to the top of the snowman's head and then press yarn into glue, cut yarn from ball and pin. Let dry completely.



4. Trim yarn between snowman's sections (neck and waist) to exaggerate the snowman's shape.

**SHOP KIT**



5. Cut one piece of **B** 4" [10 cm] long. Pin strand to the snowman head to create headband.



6. With **B** make two 2½" [6.5 cm] pompoms. Pin pompoms to each end of the headband to create earmuffs.



7. Cut three 28" [71 cm] strands of **C** yarn. Tie the strands together with 3" [7.5 cm] fringe at one end. Braid strands until 3" [7.5 cm] remain. Tie a knot at end of braid to form a scarf.



8. Tie scarf around neck of snowman. Trim ends of scarf evenly.



9. Pin or glue eyes to snowman.
