## MATERIALS

**Red Heart® Super Saver®** (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

**Version 1** (Set of 3 as shown)

**Contrast A** Shocking Pink (0718) **1 ball or 48 yds/44 m**

**Contrast B** White (0311) **1 ball or 48 yds/44 m**

**Contrast C** Gold (0321) **1 ball or 48 yds/44 m**

**Note:** Each Set of 3 shades will make 20 Ornaments.

**Version 2** (1 as shown)

**Contrast D** Black (0312) **1 ball**

**Contrast E** Soft White (0316) **1 ball**

**Contrast F** Cherry Red (0319) **1 ball**

Size U.S. K/10½ (6.5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook. Susan Bates® yarn needle. Scissors. Ruler. Cardboard cut to 4" x 6" [10 cm x 15 cm] for tassels. 1 of each Clover® Large 3¾" [85 mm], Medium 2½" [65 mm], Small 1⅝" [45 m] Pom Maker.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### ORNAMENT

#### Version 1 (Set of 3):

Make 1 - Color 1 is A, Color 2 is B, and Color 3 is C.

Make 1 - Color 1 is C, Color 2 is A, and Color 3 is B.

Make 1 - Color 1 is B, Color 2 is C, and Color 3 is A.

#### Version 2:

Make 1 - Color 1 is Color D, Color 2 is E, Color 3 is F.

### Pompoms

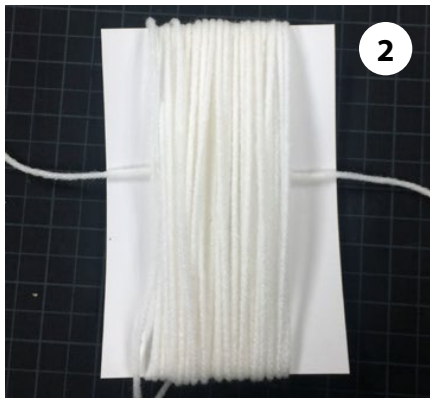
Following manufacturer's instructions, make one 3¾" [85 mm] Pompom with Color 1, one 2½" [65 mm] Pompom with Color 2, and one 1⅝" [45 mm] Pompom with Color 3. Leave long tails on Pompom ties. (They will be used to assemble the Ornament.)

### Tassel

**Step 1:** With Color 2, evenly wrap the piece of cardboard lengthwise approx 20 times (as shown in Photo 1). Cut yarn.



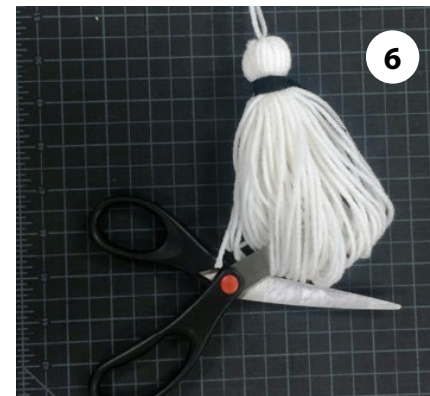
**Step 2:** Cut an 8" [20.5 cm] piece of Color 2 and thread it behind the wraps, between the cardboard and wrapped yarn. Tie a tight knot around the wrapped yarn. (Note that it may be easier to do this in the center of the cardboard.) Remove wrapped yarn from cardboard (as shown in Photos 2 & 3).



**Step 3:** Cut a 15" [38 cm] piece of Color 1. Fold the tassel in half lengthwise, then wrap the piece around the top of tassel yarn several times, just below the Color 2 knot. Tie a knot to secure (as shown in Photos 4 & 5).



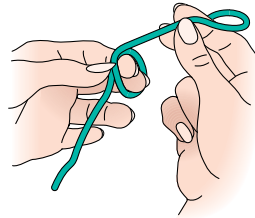
**Step 4:** Cut looped ends of Tassel. With crochet hook or yarn needle, pull ends of Color 1 through center of Tassel and trim just below the wrap (as shown in Photos 6, 7 & 8). Trim ends evenly.



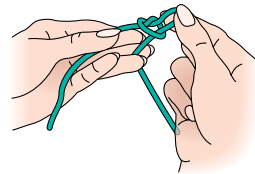
## ASSEMBLING ORNAMENT

**Step 1:** Hold 2 strands of Color 1 and 1 strand of Color 2 together. With crochet hook, crochet a 9" [23 cm] chain following the Slip Knot and Chain St instruction, leaving long tails at the beginning and end. Cut yarn, then tie long tails together to make the hanging loop.

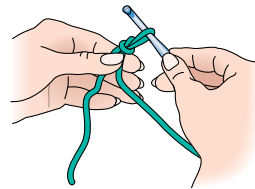
### Slip Knot



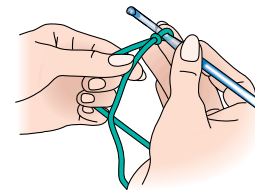
1. Make a circle with yarn or thread.



2. Pull a loop through the circle.

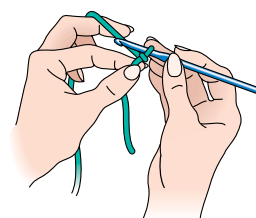


3. Insert the hook in the loop.



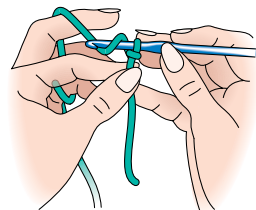
4. Pull gently and evenly to tighten the loop and slide the knot up to the hook.

### Chain Stitch...ch

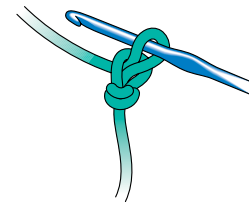
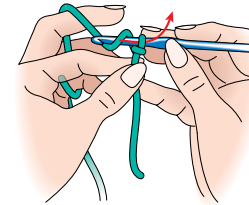


1. Hold the yarn in your left hand in a way that is comfortable for you. Hold the hook in your right hand in your preferred method. Pencil grip is shown. Hold the loop on hook between thumb and middle fingers of left hand.

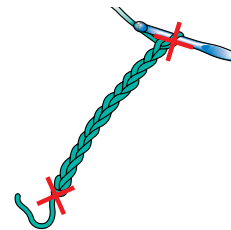
**NOTE:** As you move along the foundation chain be sure to keep moving your fingers up towards the hook.



2. Bring hook under yarn from front to back. This yarn over the hook movement is called "yarn over" abbreviated as "yo".



3. Pull hook back through loop on hook. One chain stitch made. Be careful not to tighten the previous loop.



4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 to form the number of chains called for in the pattern. Do not count the slip knot or the loop on the hook as a stitch.

Practice chaining to keep an even tension and all stitches the same size. Loops should be loose enough for hook to pass through easily.

You are now ready to learn the Single Crochet stitch, page 10.

**Step 2:** Tie Pompom Color 1 tails to hanging loop tails, joining them together. Trim all tails in Color 1 to same height of Pompom's yarn. Weave Color 2 tails into center of Pompom and trim shorter than Pompom height (as shown in photo 9).



**Step 3:** With Color 1 held single, crochet a 2½" [6 cm] chain, leaving long tails at beginning and end. Using yarn needle, weave beginning tail up through chain so there are two tails on one end of the chain. Thread Pompom Color 2 tail through chain end opposite the tails. Tie a knot and trim Color 2 tails to Pompom height (as shown in photo 10).



**Step 4:** Attach pom-pom Color 1 to Color 2 by threading long tails on chain end through center of pom-pom Color 1, securing tails around base of hanging loop with a knot. Trim tails to Pompom height (as shown on photo 11).



**Step 5:** With Color 1, crochet a 2½" [6 cm] chain, leaving long tails at beginning and end. Using yarn needle, thread Pompom Color 3's tail through bottom of chain. Tie a knot and trim Color 3 tails to Pompom height. Thread Color 2 tail through Pompom and trim shorter than Pompom height (as shown in photo 12).



**Step 6:** Attach Pompom Color 3 to bottom of Pompom Color 2 by threading long tails on chain end through center of Pompom Color 2, securing the tail around the base of first chain with a knot. Trim shorter than pom-pom height (as shown in photo 13).



**Step 7:** Thread a 24" [61 cm] length of Color 1 under top knot of tassel. Bring ends of Color 1 to meet so length is equal on both sides, then tie a knot to secure. Holding 2 strands of Color 1 together, crochet a 1½" [4 cm] chain, leaving long tails at the end. Using yarn needle, thread top Color 2 tassel yarn into tassel body (as shown in photo 14).



**Step 8:** To attach Tassel to Pom-pom Color 3, thread long chain tails through Pom-pom. Tie a knot to secure and trim tails shorter than Pom-pom height.
