



MATERIALS

Red Heart® Super Saver® O'Go™ (5 oz/141 g; 236 yds/215 m)

Christmas (7196)

1 O'Go



Two 1" [2.5 cm] metal rings. Ruler or measuring tape. Scissors.
3" [7.5 cm] piece of cardboard.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

MEASUREMENT

Approx 127" [322 cm] long.

GAUGE

16 sts and 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking stitch.

INSTRUCTIONS

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove

- For this pattern, colors can be easily separated by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use. Follow color guide shown in Materials section for each O'Go (Contrast A, B, C, D and E). You may find it helpful to place each color section in its own resealable (zip lock) bag and label each bag A, B, C, D and E

1. Cut 1 strands of A approx 130" [203.5 cm] long. Secure one 1" [2.5 cm] metal ring to each end of yarn. (Hanging Yarn).

2. **Tassels** (make 9 each with A, B, C, D, and E) Wrap yarn around a 3" [7.5 cm] piece of cardboard 30 times. Tie securely at one end. Cut across other end. Wrap yarn 3 times around tassel 1" [2.5 cm] from tied end, and fasten securely.

Tip: Steam Tassels lightly to straighten yarn.

3. Attach Tassels to Hanging Yarn approx 1½" [4 cm] apart alternating colors A, B, C, D, and E (as shown in photo).
