

CRED HEART PLASTIC CANVAS NOTIONS CASE

MATERIALS

Red Heart® Super Saver® (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

Contrast A White (0311)1 ballContrast B Pretty 'n Pink (0722)1 ballContrast C Spring Green (0672)1 ballContrast D Turqua (0512)1 ball

7 count plastic needlepoint canvas. Susan Bates® steel yarn needle. 4" x 8" [10 x 20.5 cm] piece of white felt. Hot glue gun and glue sticks.





MEASUREMENTS


Approx 7" x 3½" [18 x 9 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cut plastic canvas 48 squares wide and 57 squares tall.
- 2. Thread needle with length of yarn. Project will be worked with double thickness of yarn.
- 3. Begin working chart (see page 2), reading each color line on chart as one stitch. Hold tail of yarn at back of work.
- 4. Continue working chart catching tail of working yarn under stitches at back of work in order to secure the tail.
- 5. Once ready to tie off working yarn, tie an optional knot at back of work and thread yarn under back of stitches, securing the tail.
- 6. Repeat until chart is complete.

- 7. Fold Notions Case so bottom edge is 12 squares from top, creating pouch and flap of case. With length of A, and beginning at bottom right corner at folded edge, whip stitch side edges together, continuing up and around flap and back down side edge.
- 8. Cut 4 lengths of yarn long enough to wrap around case when closed two times.
- 9. Cut a piece of felt same size as flap.
- 10. Hot glue felt to flap, sandwiching yarn between canvas and felt to create closing ties.
