

MATERIALS
Red Heart ${ }^{\oplus}$ Scrubby ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ( $3.5 \mathrm{oz} / 100 \mathrm{~g} ; 92 \mathrm{yds} / 85 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Contrast A Candy (0934) 2 balls
Contrast B Waves (0936) 3 balls
Hot Glue Gun and glue sticks. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ yarn needle. Note: Each letter requires approx 51 yds [ 46.5 m ] yarn.


## ABBREVIATION

Approx = Approximately

## MEASUREMENT

Approx 8" [20 cm] tall.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Note:

- Surfaces that cannot be reached with wrapping will be covered with lengths of yarn first.


## Glue Outer Surfaces

Step 1: Cut lengths to cover the outer edges of the letters. It is usually not necessary to cover the entire perimeter, since the wrapping will also cover parts of the perimeter
Step 2: Beginning at any point along the area to be covered, apply an even layer of glue approximately 3 " [ 7.5 cm ] long, and extending to the outside edges. Adjust the lengths so they lie smoothly and give adequate coverage. Continue around all edges.

## Glue Corner Surfaces

Step 1: Cut lengths of yarn to cover the front and back where they will not be covered when wrapping the letters. Note that yarns will naturally overlap on some letters, like the top of 'A'.
Step 2: Glue in place.

## Wrapping

Step 1: Apply a layer of glue on back of letter in area to be wrapped.
Step 2: Leaving 2" to 3" [5 to 7.5 cm ] tails, evenly wrap yarn around letter in your color of choice.
Step 3: Use yarn needle to pull the tails under wrapped area.
