What you will need:

RED HEART® Loop-It™: 3 balls 0511 I Blue It **A**, 2 balls 0115 Snow Way **B**

Yarn needle

Gauge is not necessary for this project



RED HEART® Loop-It™, Art. E884 available in 3.5 oz (100 g), 7.6 yd (7 m) balls

Fair Isle Loop-It Pillow

This pillow is made with Loop-It yarn, which means you can make it without knowing how to knit! The charts provided have designs for a snowflake and a heart, but with some graph paper you can make your own design!

SHOP KIT

Pillowcase measures 23" (58.4 cm) x 15" (38.1 cm).

NOTE

1. Finger looping fun.™ No tools required!
2. Begin work on a flat surface. Stitches are worked by pulling loops of yarn through a row of previous loops. Right side will be facing throughout.
3. To join balls of yarn, overlap three loops from the end of the first ball with three loops from the beginning of the second ball and work overlapping loops as one.
4. Following traditional stranded fair isle techniques, the corresponding yarn color will be pulled through according to graph color. Yarn in contrast color will be carried loosely behind work and will create floats.
5. When switching colors on a row, count out as many loops in main color as will be used in contrasting color plus 1. This length of main color will be carried loosely along the wrong side of work in the contrasting color sections.

PILLOWCASE

Follow the chart of your choice throughout.

To create base row, start with 23 loops of **A**.

Row 1 (Right Side): Working from right to left, pull loops of working yarn through the loops of base row loops working from back to front – knit row formed. Do Not Turn Work.

Row 2: Working from left to right, pull loops of working yarn through the loops of base row loops working from back to front – knit row formed. Do Not Turn Work.



Row 3: Working from right to left, pull loops of working yarn through the loops of base row loops working from back to front – knit row formed. Do Not Turn Work.

Rows 4-23: Beginning with Row 4 of chart for color changes, repeat Rows 2-3. Cut **B**.

Row 24: With **A** only, working from left to right, pull loops of working yarn through the loops of base row loops working from back to front – knit row formed. Do Not Turn Work.

Row 25: Beginning with Row 1 of chart for color changes, repeat Row 3.

Rows 26-47: Following Rows 2-23 of chart for color changes, repeat Rows 2-3.

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
