

### CRED HEART POMPOM GARDEN PILLOW

#### **MATERIALS**

Red Heart® Super Saver® (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

Contrast A Jade (3862) 2 balls or 707 yds/646.5 m

Contrast B Tea Leaf (0624) 2 balls or 402 yds/367.5 m

1 ball or 205 yds/187.5 m **Contrast C** Medium Purple (0528)

**Contrast D** Shocking Pink (0718) 1 ball or 193 yds/176.5 m

Contrast E White (0311) 1 ball or 193 yds/176.5 m

**Contrast F** Perfect Pink (0706) 1 ball or 193 yds/176.5 m

Contrast G Royal (0385) 1 ball or 193 yds/176.5 m

Contrast H Gold (0321) 1 ball or 193 yds/176.5 m

Susan Bates® yarn needle. 20" [51 cm] square pillow cover and pillow form. 21½" [54.5 cm] square piece of latch hook canvas. Scissors. Ruler. Clover® Medium 2½" [65 mm] Pom Maker. Coats and Clark® All Purpose sewing thread to match Contrast A. Sewing needle.





#### **MEASUREMENT**

Approx 20" [51 cm] square.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

#### **PILLOW**

Pompoms (Make 21 in A; 12 in B; 6 in each of C, D, E, F, and G; and 5 in H).

Wind yarn around first half of tool until full. Wind yarn around second half of tool until full (see tool manufacturer's instructions). Cut. Secure, leaving a long tail for attaching pompom to canvas. Trim to shape, being sure not to cut tails.




#### **ASSEMBLY**

# **Canvas Edge Finishing:**

See diagrams on page 2. With 2 strands of A and yarn needle, finish all 4 edges of latch hook canvas as follows:

1. Evenly trim latch hook canvas to 21½" [54.5 cm] square. Trim and remove 2" [5 cm] from all 4 corners.







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
- 2. Fold 2" [5 cm] of unfinished edges to wrong side of work.
- 3. With yarn needle and 2 strands of A held together, whip stitch around 3 unfinished edge squares, working down and around unfinished edge on right side of work and up and through back (working through both thicknesses) to secure folded edge in place.






4. Tie off strands to secure and weave in ends.

#### **Edge Finishing**



1. Evenly trim Latch Canvas to 21½" [54.5 cm] square. Trim and remove 2" [5 cm] from corners.




3. With yarn needle and 2 strands of A held together, whip stitch around 3 unfinished edge squares, working down and around unfinished edge

# Attaching Pompoms to Finished Canvas

Using 'tails' of yarn from each Pompom, tie Pompoms evenly across finished Latch Canvas, overlapping finished edges, following color placement as shown in diagram.

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## **Attaching Canvas to Pillow front:**

Center finished Canvas with Pompoms at center front of pillowcase as shown in diagram. With thread and needle, whip stitch fully around outer edge of Canvas, securing to front of pillowcase, being careful not to bunch fabric, or catch back of pillowcase. Fasten off and weave in ends.
