## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Pomp-a-Doodle™:** 1 ball 9753 Party Mix

- Chenille stems in a variety of colors (2 for each spider)
- Small amounts of felt in varying colors
- Black felt, construction paper or poster board
- Wiggly eyes
- Tacky glue
- Wood dowels (optional)

# Crafty Spiders and Bats

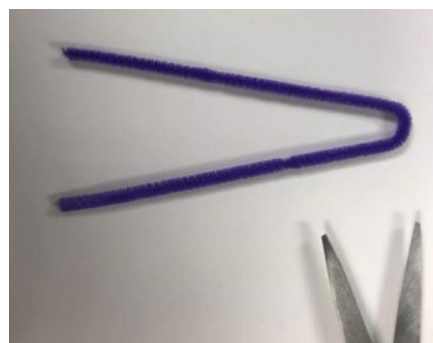
Creepy crawly spiders and spooky bats are super fun and easy to make! Using Pomp-a-Doodle yarn means that the pompoms are already made for you... just cut them from the yarn.

## SPIDERS

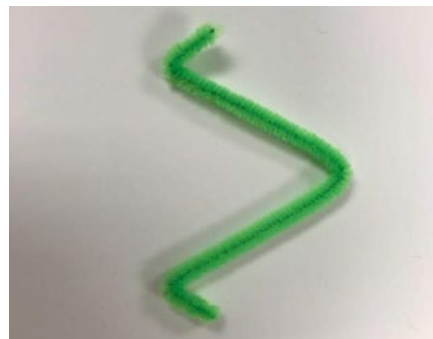
1. Using sharp craft scissors cut individual pompoms out of the yarn.



2. Cut two chenille stems in half; bend each of the 4 pieces in half.



3. Turn up ½" (1.3 cm) on each leg.



4. Glue all 4 sets of legs to the bottom of the pompom using tacky glue.



5. For mouth, cut a small semi-circle out of felt in varying colors.



6. Using photo as a guide, glue mouth and wiggly eyes in place for face.

7. Allow to dry fully for 2-4 hours.  
Referring to photo, bend legs as desired.

## BATS

1. Using sharp craft scissors cut individual pompoms out of the yarn leaving a 2-3" (5 - 7.6 cm) tail of yarn.



2. Cut out bat wings using black felt, construction paper or poster board. (template on right) Overlap the wing tabs and glue together.



3. Glue the pompom to the center of the bat wings with the yarn tail on the top.



4. Glue wiggly eyes to the front of the bat.



5. Tape yarn tail to dowel, if desired.
