What you will need:

RED HEART® Sizzle™: 1 spool  
8269 Neon Orange or 8529  
Parakeet (or your favorite color)

Sewing scissors, tape measure,  
lighter (**use adult supervision**),  
tape (if working alone), 2 pencils  
(if working with friend)

RED HEART® Sizzle™, 100% Nylon  
Thread, Art. 146 available in 100 yd  
(91 m) spools

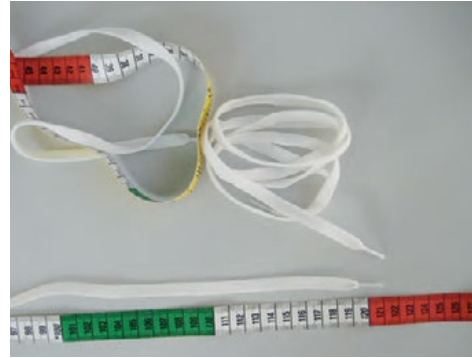


# Twisted Shoelaces

*Change up your sneaker laces with these easy-to-make Sizzle shoe laces. Perfect for brightening up your style!*

## SHOELACES

**Step 1:** Measure length of shoelaces  
(e.g., 39" [120 cm]).



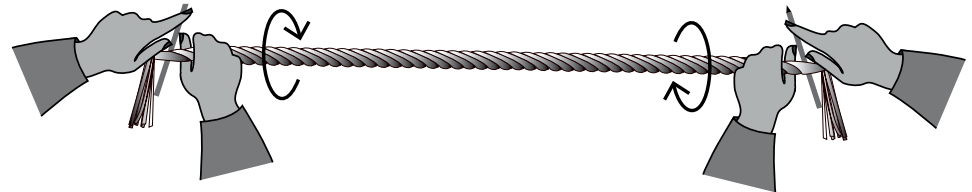
**Step 2:** Measure 8 lengths of cord, each twice as long as shoelace (e.g. 78" [240cm]). Tie cords together in overhand knot at each end.

If working with a friend, each take an end and insert a pencil between strands. If working by yourself, tape 1 end to table and insert pencil in other end.



**Step 3:** Holding ends and pencil in one hand and keeping cords taut, twist cords.

If working with a friend, twist in opposite directions. If working by yourself, twist in 1 direction only.

SHOP KIT

**Step 4:** When the cord is overtisted but not kinked, take hold of center point in one hand. Holding loop and ends taut, begin to bring 2 sides of cord toward each other.

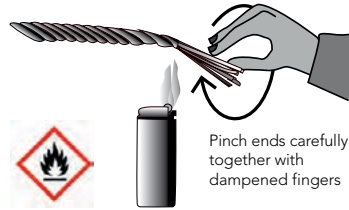


**Step 6:** Hold knot ends together; cut off knots.

**Make aglet:** hold ends to flame of lighter to melt together, pinching with damp fingers to create a point.

Cut through loop on other end; make aglet.

Make 2 shoe laces in the required length



**Step 5:** Cords will naturally begin to twist around one another. Adjust so twists are even along entire length.
