

## 5/Bitty Boomerang

## ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Beg $=$ Beginning
Ch = Chain(s)
Dc = Double crochet
Rep $=$ Repeat
RS $=$ Right side
$\mathbf{S c}=$ Single crochet
Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 sc . Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook
SI st = Slip stitch
Sp(s) = Space(s)
St(s) = Stitch (es)
WS = Wrong side
Yoh = Yarn over hook

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 14 " x 60" $[35.5 \times 152.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] including fringe

## GAUGE

16 sts and 12 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in pat

## INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Ch 3 at beg of row counts as dc.

## SHAWL

## Ch 4.

1 st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end of chain. Turn. 3 sc .
2nd row: Ch 3.1 dc in next sc. 3 dc in last sc. Turn. 5 dc .

3rd row: Ch 1.3 sc in first dc. 1 sc in each of next 2 dc . Sc2tog. Turn. 6 sts.
4th row: Ch 3.1 dc in each st to last sc. 3 dc in last sc. Turn.
5th row: Ch 1.3 sc in first dc. 1 sc in each dc to last 2 dc. Sc2tog. Turn.
Rep 4th and 5th rows until there are 109 sts, ending on sc-row.
Next row: Ch 3.1 dc in each st to end of row. Fasten off.

TRIM
Ch 4.
1st row: ( 2 dc . Ch 2.3 dc ) in 4th ch from hook. Turn.

## MATERIALS

Sugar Bush ${ }^{\circledR}$ Itty-Bitty ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ( $1.75 \mathrm{oz} / 50 \mathrm{~g} ; 153 \mathrm{yds} / 140 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Plum Perfect (5018) 4 balls
Size U.S. I/9 ( 5.5 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Stitch marker.

2nd row: Ch 8. SI st in 6th ch from hook. Ch 7. SI st in same sp as last sl st. Ch 5. SI st in same sp as last sl st trefoil made. Ch 2. (3 dc. Ch 2.3 dc ) in next ch-2 sp. Turn.
3rd row: SI st in each of first 3 dc and next ch-2 sp. Ch 3. (2 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc ) in same sp as last sl st. Turn. Rep 2nd and 3rd rows until work measures length to fit along shaped edge of shawl, ending on 2nd row of pat (approx 46 trefoils). Do not turn at end of last row.

Next row: Working across long edge of Trim, *Ch 3.1 sc in top of row-end st. Rep from * to end of row, ending with 1 sc in top of beg ch 4 . Fasten off leaving a long end for sewing.

## FINISHING

Pin all pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry.
With RS facing, using whip st, sew Trim to shaped edge of Shawl.
