# **Crochet Hook Requirements:**

US 7 (4.5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge

### Materials:

Yarn needle

## Gauge:

4 rnds of Granny Square = 4" [10 cm]

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ( ). If one number is given, it applies to all sizes.

### **TANK**

Granny Square: Make 4

Rnd 1: Magic Circle (adjustable ring) Ch 1. Work 12 sc in ring. Pull ring tight. SI st to first sc to join.

Rnd 2: Ch 17. Sl st to first st. \*Ch 17. Sl st to next st. Rep from \* around (12 loops made). Fasten off. Weave in end.

Rnd 3: Join yarn with a sl st to centre of first loop. Ch 4. Work 1 sc in next loop. Ch 4. Work (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) in next loop. \*Ch 4. Work 1 sc in next loop. Ch 4. Work 1 sc in next loop. Ch 4. Work (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) in next loop. Rep from \* 2 more times, ending with ch 4. Work 1 sc in sl st at beg of rnd. Fasten off. Weave in end.

Rnd 4: Join yarn with a sl st to any ch-2

sp corner. Ch 3. Work (2 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) in ch-2 sp. \*Ch 2. Work 3 dc in ch-4 sp 3 times. Ch 2. Work (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) in ch-2 sp. Rep from \* 2 more times. Ch 2. Work 3 dc in ch-4 sp 3 times. Ch 2. Sl st to top of beg ch 3 to join.


Rnd 5: SI st over to ch-2 sp. Ch 3. Work (2 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) in ch-2 sp. \*Ch 4. Work 1 dc in ch-2 sp 4 times. Ch 4. Work (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) in ch-2 sp. Rep from \* 2 more times. Ch 4. Work 1 dc in ch-2 sp 4 times. Ch 4. Sl st to top of beg ch 3 to join.

Rnd 6: SI st over to ch-2 sp. Ch 3. Work (2 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) in ch-2 sp. \*Ch 4. Work 1 dc in ch-4 sp 5 times. Ch 4. Work (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) in ch-2 sp. Rep from \* 2 more times. Ch 4. Work 1 dc



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


in ch-4 sp 5 times. Ch 4. Sl st to top of beg ch 3 to join.

Cont increasing Granny Square by repeating Rnds 4 to 6 for pat. Work until square measures approx 17 (181/2)" [43 (47) cm], ending on Rnd 4. Block squares to a finished measurement of 18½ (**20**)" [47 (**51**) cm].

### Assembly:

Lay out all 4 squares to make one large square. With RS facing, whip stitch each square tog from the outside inward 121/2 (131/2)" [32 (34.5) cm]. Leave rem 6  $(6^{1/2})^{"}$  [15 (16.5) cm] for neck opening and armholes.

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### Straps:

### Front Right:

Row 1: Join yarn with a sl st in ch-2 sp of inside corner square #1. Ch 1 (does not count as st here and throughout). Work 3 sc in ch-2 sp. Turn. 3 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1. Work 1 sc in each of next 3 sts. Turn.

Rep Row 2 until Strap measures 5 (6)" [12.5 (15) cm]. Fasten off, leaving a tail for sewing. Sew Strap to ch-2 sp inside corner square #3. Weave in ends.

### Front Left:

Row 1: Join yarn with a sl st in ch-2 sp of inside corner square #2. Ch 1 (does not count as st here and throughout). Work 3 sc in ch-2 sp. Turn. 3 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1. Work 1 sc in each of next 3 sts. Turn.

Rep Row 2 until Strap measures 6 (7)" [15 (18) cm]. Fasten off, leaving a tail for sewing. Sew Strap to ch-2 sp inside corner square #4. Weave in ends.


### **FINISHING**

### Neck:

Join yarn to any stitch at back of neck. Ch 1. Work 1 sc evenly around neckline. SI st to first sc to join. Fasten off and weave in ends.

### Armhole:

Join yarn to any stitch at back of armhole. Ch 1. Work 1 sc evenly around. SI st to first sc to join. Fasten off and weave in ends. Rep for second armhole.
