

SUGAR BUSH

SWEETHEART COLLARED KNIT SHAWL CARDIGAN | KNIT



MATERIALS

Sugar Bush® **Rapture**™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 211 yds/193 m)

Sizes 2/3XL 4/5XL Ravishing Rose (1011) balls

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) circular knitting needles 32" [80 cm] long. Set of 4 size U.S. 11 (8 mm) double-pointed knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. Stitch markers. Size U.S. L/11 (8 mm) crochet hook for provisional cast on. 20 yds [18.5 m] of bulky weight waste yarn.



W&T = Bring yarn to front of work. Slip next stitch purlwise. Bring yarn to back of work. Slip stitch back onto left-hand needle. Turn.





SIZES

To fit bust measurement

XS/S 28-34" [71-86.5 cm] 36-38" [91.5-96.5 cm] M 40-42" [101.5-106.5 cm] XL 44-46" [112-117 cm] 2/3XL 48-54" [122-137 cm] 4/5XL 56-62" [142-157.5 cm]

GAUGE

12 sts and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st with 2 strands of yarn

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger size(s) the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.



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Notes: Shawl is worked from center back with a provisional cast on. Each half of Body is worked outward from the cast on.

Fronts are shaped with short-turn rows.

Sleeves are worked from shoulder to cuff

Shawl is worked with 2 strands of yarn held tog throughout.

Crochet Provisional Cast On: Using waste yarn, crochet a chain a few stitches longer than the number of stitches to be cast on. Fasten off and cut yarn. Flip chain over and working in the back "bump" of each chain, pick up and knit the required number of stitches with the main yarn. To remove the waste yarn later, pick out the fastened-off end and unravel the chain, placing the stitches on a needle as you go.

Using crochet provisional cast on method, pick up **50** (**51-53-55**-57-59) sts on circular needle. Do **not** join. Working back and forth across needle, proceed as follows:

Right Back

1st row: (RS). Knit.

2nd row: Purl. Use backwards loop method to cast on 10 sts. 60 (61-63-65-67-69) sts.

3rd row: SI1Pwyif. Knit to end of

4th row: Purl to last 12 sts. K12. 5th and 6th rows: Rep 3rd and 4th rows once more.

7th row: SI1Pwyif. Knit to end of row.

8th row: Purl to last 3 sts. K3. Rep last 2 rows until work from beg measures 63/4 (73/4-83/4-93/4-103/4-113/4)" [17 (19.5-22-25-27.5-**30**) cm], ending on a WS row.

Armhole: Next row: (RS). Cont as established to last 17 (18-20-22-24-26) sts. Using waste yarn K12 (13-15-17-19-21). Slip waste yarn sts from right-hand needle back to left-hand needle. With main yarn, knit to end of row. (Waste yarn will be removed later to make Armhole Opening).

Right Front

Cont even until work from armhole row measures 1/2 (11/2-21/2-31/2-41/2-5½)" [**1.5** (**4-6-9-11.5-14**) cm], ending on a WS row.

Shape Right Front:**1st row: (RS). SI1Pwyif. Knit to last 9 (9-10-10-11-11) sts. W&T.

2nd row: Purl to last 3 sts. K3. 3rd row: SI1Pwyif. Knit to 9 (9-10-10-11-11) sts before last wrapped st. W&T.

4th row: Purl to last 3 sts. K3. Rep 3rd and 4th rows 3 times more. Next row: (RS). SI1Pwyif. Knit to end of row, picking up and knitting wraps tog with wrapped sts.

last 3 sts. K3.**

Rep from ** to ** 9 times more.

Right Front Edging: 1st row: SI1Pwyif. Knit to end of row. Rep last row 3 times more. Cast off.

Left Back

Remove waste yarn provisional cast on and slip 50 (51-53-55-57-59) sts on circular ending on a WS row. needle. PM at end of row. Do **not** join. Working back and forth across needle, proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). Knit. Use backwards loop method, cast on 10 sts. 60 (61-63-65-67-69) sts.

2nd row: SI1Pwyif. K11. Purl to end of row.

3rd row: Knit.

4th and 5th rows: As 2nd and 3rd rows.

6th row: SI1Pwyif. K2. Purl to end of row.

Rep 5th and 6th rows until work from marked row measures 63/4 $(7\frac{3}{4} - 8\frac{3}{4} - 9\frac{3}{4} - 10\frac{3}{4} - 11\frac{3}{4})$ "[17] (19.5-22-25-27.5-30) cm], ending on a WS row.

Armhole: Next row: (RS). SI1Pwyif. K4. With waste yarn, K12 (13-15-**Next row:** (WS). Sl1Pwyif. Purl to 17-19-21). Slip waste yarn sts from right-hand needle back to left-hand needle. With main yarn, knit to end of row. (Waste yarn will be removed later to make the armhole opening.)

Left Front

Cont even until work from armhole from row measures 1/2 (11/2-21/2-31/2-41/2-5½)" [1.5 (4-6-9-11.5-14) cm],



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Shape Left Front: ***1st row: (RS). Knit.

2nd row: Sl1Pwyif. K2. Purl to last sts. W&T. **9** (9-10-10-11-11) sts. W&T.

3rd row: Knit.

4th row: SI1Pwyif. K2. Purl to **9** (9-10-10-11-11) sts before last wrapped st. W&T.

5th row: Knit.

Rep 4th and 5th rows 3 times more.

Next row: (WS). SI1Pwyif. K3. Purl to end of row, picking up and purling wraps tog with wrapped sts.***

Rep from *** to *** 9 times more.

Left Front Edging: 1st row: Sl1wyif. Knit to end of row. Rep the last row 3 times more. Cast off.

Collar: With WS facing and circular needle, pick up and knit 59 (67-76-85-94-102) sts along top edge of shawl. Do not join. Working back and forth across needle, proceed as follows:

1st row: SI1Pwyif. Knit to end of row.

Rep last row **5** (7-7-7-7) times more.

Shape Collar: 1st and 2nd rows:

SI1Pwyif. Knit to last 2 (3-3-3-4-4)

3rd and 4th rows: Knit to 2 (3-3-3-4-4) sts before last wrapped st. W&T.

5th to 8th rows: Knit to **5** (**5**-**6**-7-7-8) sts before last wrapped st. W&T.

9th and 10th rows: Knit to 10 (11-12-13-14-14) sts before last wrapped st. W&T.

Next row: (RS). Knit to end of row, picking up and knitting wraps tog with wrapped sts.

Cast off knitwise, picking up and knitting rem wraps tog with wrapped sts.

Sleeves

With RS facing, remove waste yarn from armhole row and slip **12** (**13-15-17-19-21**) sts from top of opening and 11 (12-14-16-18-20) sts from bottom of opening onto double-pointed needles. Divide sts onto 3 needles. Beg at Knit 1 rnd. bottom of armhole, pick up and knit 1 st. Knit to top of armhole. Pick Cast off knitwise. up and knit 3 sts at top of opening. Knit to end of rnd. Pick up and knit FINISHING 1 st from bottom of opening. Join in rnd. PM for beg of rnd. 28 (30-34-38-42-46) sts.

Knit 17 (17-11-10-7-7) rnds.

Next rnd: ssk. Knit to last 2 sts. K2toa.

Knit 17 (17-11-9-7-6) rnds even. Rep last **18** (**18-12-10-8-7**) rnds 2 (2-4-5-7-8) times more. 20 (22-22-24-24-26) sts rem.

Purl 1 rnd.

Purl 1 rnd.

Pin garment to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry.
