## 2/Twinkle Your Toes

**Sizes:**

	Girls'	Boys'	Women's	Men's
<b>Foot Length:</b>				
inches	6"	7 1/2"	10 1/2"	11"

**Yarn Requirements:** Sugar Bush Itty-Bitty shown in:

Girls' - 5015 Autumn Glory	1 ball
Boys' - 5021 Erie Shores	1 ball
Women's - 5017 Sailor's Sky Delight	2 balls
Men's - 5025 Sand and Sunset	2 balls

**Knitting Needle Requirements:**

Set of four US 3 (3.25 mm) double-pointed needles **or size needed to obtain gauge**

**Abbreviations:** see page 3

**Materials:**

Stitch markers, Yarn needle

**Gauge:**

28 sts and 36 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stockinette st.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

Cast on 40 (48, 56, 64) sts loosely.

Divide into 12 (16, 18, 21) sts on 1st needle, 16 (16, 20, 22) sts on 2nd needle and 12 (16, 18, 21) sts on 3rd needle.

Join in rnd and place marker on 1st st.

Work in (K1, P1) ribbing for 2 (2 1/2, 3, 3 1/2)" [5 (6, 7.5, 9) cm].

Proceed in (K3, P1) ribbing until work from beg measures 3 (4, 5, 5 1/2)" [7.5 (10, 12.5, 14) cm], ending with 3rd needle.

**Arrange heel:**

Slip 2 (4, 4, 5) sts from end of 1st needle onto beg of 2nd needle, and 2 (4, 4, 5) sts from beg of 3rd needle onto end of 2nd needle, 10 (12, 14, 16) sts on 1st needle, 20 (24, 28, 32) sts on 2nd needle, and 10 (12, 14, 16) sts on 3rd needle.

Divide the 20 (24, 28, 32) sts on 2nd needle onto 2 needles and leave for

insep.

Knit the 10 (12, 14, 16) sts off 1st needle onto end of 3rd needle.

Working on these 20 (24, 28, 32) sts proceed as follows:

**Next row:** (WS). K1, P8 (10, 12, 14).

P2tog. P8 (10, 12, 14). K1, 19 (23, 27, 31) sts.

**Next row:** K1, Sl1, to end of row.

**Next row:** Purl.

Repeat last two rows for 1 1/2" [4 cm].

**Make heel:**

**Row 1:** P10 (12, 14, 16). P2tog. P1. Turn.

**Row 2:** K3. Sl1. K1. pss0. K1. Turn.

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**Row 3:** P4. P2tog. P1. Turn.

**Row 4:** K5. Sl1. K1. pss0. K1. Turn.

**Row 5:** P6. P2tog. P1. Turn.

**Row 6:** K7. Sl1. K1. pss0. K1. Turn.

**Row 7:** P8. P2tog. P1. Turn.

**Row 8:** K9. Sl1. K1. pss0. K1. Turn. 11 sts.

**Boys' size only:**

**Row 9:** P10. P2tog. P1. Turn.

**Row 10:** K11. Sl1. K1. pss0. K1. Turn. 13 sts.

**Men's and Women's sizes only:**

**Row 9:** P10. P2tog. P1. Turn.

**Row 10:** K11. Sl1. K1. pss0. K1. Turn.

**Row 11:** P12. P2tog. P1. Turn.

**Row 12:** K13. Sl1. K1. pss0. K1. Turn. 15 sts.

**Men's size only:**

**Row 13:** P14. P2tog. P1. Turn.



**Row 14:** K15. Sl1. K1. pss0. K1. Turn. 17 sts.

**Make instep:**

Slip 20 (24, 28, 32) sts for instep onto one needle.

1st needle - with RS of work facing and using the heel needle, pick up and knit 9 (11, 13, 15) sts along side of heel.

2nd needle - rib across instep sts.

3rd needle - pick up and knit 9 (11, 13, 15) sts along other side of heel and K5 (6, 7, 8) from 1st needle onto 3rd needle.

Sts are now divided as follows:

1st needle 15 (18, 21, 24) sts.

2nd needle 20 (24, 28, 32) sts.

3rd needle 14 (17, 20, 23) sts.

**Rnd 1:** 1st needle, K6 (8, 9, 10). K2tog. K7 (8, 10, 12). 2nd needle, Rib. 3rd needle, Knit.

**Rnd 2:** 1st needle, Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 2nd needle, Rib. 3rd needle, K1. Sl1. K1. pss0. Knit to end.

**Rnd 3:** 1st needle, Knit. 2nd needle, Rib. 3rd needle, Knit.

Rep last 2 rounds to 10 (12, 13, 13) sts on 1st needle. 20 (24, 28, 32) sts on 2nd needle. 10 (12, 13, 13) sts on 3rd needle. 40 (48, 54, 58) sts in round. Keeping 2nd needle in ribbing cont even until foot, from pick up sts at

heel, measures 4 (5, 6 1/2, 7 1/2)" [10 (12.5, 16.5, 19) cm].

**Shape toe:**

**Rnd 1:** 1st needle, Knit to last 3 sts.

K2tog. K1. 2nd needle, K1. Sl1. K1. pss0. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 3rd needle, K1. Sl1. K1. pss0. Knit to end.

**Rnd 2:** Knit across each needle.

Rep these 2 rounds row: 16 (20, 26, 30) sts, in round.

Knit the sts of 1st needle onto end of 3rd needle. Break yarn, leaving an end 8" [20.5 cm] long for grafting toe. Graft 2 sets of 8 (10, 13, 15) sts.

ABBREVIATIONS

- alt = alternate(ing)
- approx = approximately
- beg = begin/beginning
- ch = chain
- cn = cable needle
- cont = continue/continuing
- dc = double crochet
- dc2tog = double crochet decrease
- dec = decrease/decreases/decreasing
- dpn(s) = double-pointed needle(s)
- hdc = half double crochet
- inc = increase/increases/increasing
- k = knit
- k2(3)tog = knit next 2 (3) stitches together
- M1 = make 1 st by picking up horizontal loop lying before next st and knitting into back of loop
- p = purl
- p2tog = purl next 2 stitches together
- p2togtbl = purl next 2 stitches together through back loops
- pat = pattern
- pm = place marker
- psso = pass slipped stitch over
- rem = remain/remaining
- rep = repeat
- rnd(s) = round(s)
- RS = right side
- sc = single crochet
- sk = skip
- skd = skipped
- sl = slip
- sl st = slip stitch
- sl1 = slip 1 stitch
- slk = slip next stitch knitwise
- slp = slip next stitch purlwise
- sm = slip marker
- sp = space
- ssk = slip 2 sts knitwise, one at a time, insert left needle into front of these 2 stitches, then knit them together through the back loops
- St st = stockinette stitch
- st(s) = stitch(es)
- tbl = through back loop(s)
- tog = together
- WS = wrong side
- yfwd = yarn forward
- yo = yarn over

STITCH GLOSSARY

- Garner St = knit every row. (Rnds – knit 1 rnd, purl 1 rnd.)
- Stockinette st = (Rows) knit on RS, purl on WS. (Rnds – knit every rnd.)
- Reverse stockinette st = (Rows) purl on RS, knit on WS. (Rnds – purl every rnd.)
