Sizes:

	S	M	L
Finished Foot Length:

Yarn Requirements: Sugar Bush Itty-Bitty (shown in 5011 Fiery Sky)

balls	2	3	3
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Knitting Needle Requirements:

Sets of 4 US 2 (2.75 mm) and US 6 (4 mm) double-pointed needles **or size needed to obtain gauge**

Abbreviations: see page 3

Materials:

Stitch marker, Yarn needle

Gauge:

34 sts and 44 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stockinette st.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 62 (70, 70) sts loosely. Divide into 20 (24, 24) sts on 1st needle, 22 (24, 24) sts on 2nd needle, and 20 (22, 22) sts on 3rd needle. Join in rnd, place marker at 1st st.

Rnd 1: *K1. P1. Rep from * around.

This rnd forms rib pat.

Cont in rib pat until work from beg

measures 1½" [4 cm].

Knit 1 rnd, inc 1 (O, O) sts on 1st needle. 63 (70, 70) sts.

Proceed in pat as follows:

Rnd 1: *K2tog. yfwd. K5. Rep from * around.

Rnd 2: *yfwd. K1. yfwd. Sl1. K1. pssso. K2. K2tog. Rep from * around.

Rnd 3: *K3. yfwd. Sl1. K1. pssso. K2tog. yfwd. Rep from * around.

Rnd 4: Knit.

Rnd 5: *K5. yfwd. Sl1. K1. pssso. Rep from * around.

Rnd 6: *Sl1. K1. pssso. K2. K2tog. yfwd. K1. yfwd. Rep from * around.

Rnd 7: *yfwd. Sl1. K1. pssso. K2tog. yfwd. K3. Rep from * around.

Rnd 8: Knit.

These 8 rows form Lace pat.

Cont in Lace pat until work from beg measures 4½" [11.5 cm].

Rearrange sts as follows:

Slip first 9 sts from 2nd needle, onto end of 1st needle. Slip 2 sts from end of 3rd needle, onto beg of 1st needle. There are now 31 (35, 35) sts on 1st needle.

Divide rem 32 (35, 35) sts from 2nd and 3rd needles onto 2 needles and

leave for instep.

Heel:

Join yarn to end of 1st needle and proceed as follows:

Row 1: (WS). Purl.

Row 2: *K1. Sl1K. Rep from * to last st. K1.

Row 3: K1. Purl to last st. K1.

Rep last 2 rows until heel measures 2 1/2" [6 cm], ending on 2nd row.

Shape heel:

Row 1: P15 (17, 17). P2tog. P1. Turn.

Row 2: K3. Sl1. K1. pssso. K1. Turn.

Row 3: P4. P2tog. P1. Turn.

Row 4: K5. Sl1. K1. pssso. K1. Turn.

Row 5: P6. P2tog. P1. Turn.

Row 6: K7. Sl1. K1. pssso. K1. Turn.

Row 7: P8. P2tog. P1. Turn.

Row 8: K9. Sl1. K1. pssso. K1. Turn.

Row 9: P10. P2tog. P1. Turn.

Row 10: K11. Sl1. K1. pssso. K1. Turn.

Row 11: P12. P2tog. P1. Turn.

Row 12: K13. Sl1. K1. pssso. K1. Turn.

Row 13: P14. P2tog. P1. Turn.

Size S only:

Row 14: K15. Sl1. K1. pssso. Turn.

Row 15: P15. P2tog. 16 sts.

Sizes M and L only:

Row 14: K15. Sl1. K1. pssso. K1. Turn.

Row 15: P16. P2tog. P1. Turn.

Row 16: K17. Sl1. K1. pssso. Turn.

Row 17: P17. P2tog. 18 sts.

All Sizes, shape instep:

With RS of work facing and 1st needle, pick up and knit 21 sts along left side of heel.

With 2nd needle, K2. Work across 28 (35, 35) sts in Lace pat. K2.

With 3rd needle, pick up and knit 31 sts along right side of heel. Knit first 8 (9, 9) sts from heel onto end of 3rd needle. Slip rem 8 (9, 9) sts from heel onto beg of 1st needle.

90 (95, 95) sts are now divided as: 29 (30, 30) sts on 1st needle, 32 (35, 35) sts on 2nd needle, and 29 (30, 30) sts on 3rd needle.

Rnd 1: 1st needle, Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 2nd needle, K2 (O, O). Work next 28 (35, 35) sts in Lace pat. K2 (O, O). 3rd needle, K1. Sl1K. K1. pssso. Knit to end of needle.

Rnd 2: 1st needle, Knit. 2nd needle, K2 (O, O). Work pat to last 2 sts. K2 (O, O). 3rd needle, Knit.

Rep last 2 rnds until there are 64 (71, 71) sts divided as:

16 (18, 18) sts on 1st needle, 32 (35, 35) sts on 2nd needle, and 16 (18, 18) sts on 3rd needle.

Cont even, working 2nd needle, in pat, until foot from picked up sts at heel measures 5 (6, 6 1/2)" [12.5 (15, 16.5) cm], at beg of last rnd. 64 (70, 70) sts. There are now 16 (17, 17) sts on 1st

needle, 32 (35, 35) sts on 2nd needle, 16 (18, 18) sts on 3rd needle.

Shape toe:

Rnd 1: 1st needle, Knit to last 3 sts.

K2tog. K1. 2nd needle, K1. Sl1. K1. pssso. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 3rd needle, K1. Sl1K. K1. pssso. Knit to end of needle.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rep last 2 rnds until there are 20 (22, 22) sts divided as 5 sts on 1st needle, 10 (11, 11) sts on 2nd needle, and 5 (6, 6) sts on 3rd needle.

Divide sts evenly onto 2 needles.

Graft 2 sets of 10 (11, 11) sts tog for toe. Block on sock blockers or press lightly on WS using damp cloth.

STITCH GLOSSARY

Garner St = knit every row. (Rnds – knit 1 rnd, purl 1 rnd.)

Stockinette st = (Rows) knit on RS, purl on WS. (Rnds – knit every rnd.)

Reverse stockinette st = (Rows) purl on RS, knit on WS. (Rnds – purl every rnd.)
