

## Materials:

Stitch marker, Yarn needle

## Gauge:

34 sts and 44 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in stockinette st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on $62(\mathbf{7 0}, 70)$ sts loosely. Divide into $20(\mathbf{2 4}, 24)$ sts on 1st needle, 22 $\mathbf{( 2 4}, 24)$ sts on 2 nd needle, and 20
$(\mathbf{2 2}, 22)$ sts on 3rd needle. Join in rnd, place marker at 1st st.
Rnd 1: *Kı. P1. Rep from * around. This rnd forms rib pat.
Cont in rib pat until work from beg

## 8/Posh Socks

Sizes:

## Finished Foot Length:

Yarn Requirements: Sugar Bush Itty-Bitty (shown in 5011 Fiery Sky)
$\begin{array}{llll}\text { balls } & 2 & 3 & 3\end{array}$
Knitting Needle Requirements:
Sets of 4 US $2(2.75 \mathrm{~mm})$ and US $6(4 \mathrm{~mm})$ double-pointed needles or size needed to obtain gauge

Abbreviations: see page 3
measures $\mathrm{I}^{1 / 2 " ~}[4 \mathrm{~cm}]$.
Knit 7 rnd, inc $7(\mathbf{0}, 0)$ sts on 1st
needle. 63 ( 70,70 ) sts.
Proceed in pat as follows:
Rnd 1: *K2tog. yfwd. K5. Rep from * around.
Rnd 2: *yfwd. K1. yfwd. Slı. K1. psso.
K2. K2tog. Rep from * around.
Rnd 3: *K3. yfwd. Slı. K1. psso. K2tog. yfwd. Rep from * around.
Rnd 4: Knit.
Rnd 5: *K5. yfwd. Sl1. K1. psso. Rep from * around.
Rnd 6: *S11. K1. psso. K2. K2tog. yfwd. K1. yfwd. Rep from * around.

Rnd 7: *yfwd. Sl1. K1. psso. K2tog. yfwd. K3. Rep from * around.
Rnd 8: Knit.
These 8 rows form Lace pat.
Cont in Lace pat until work from beg measures $4^{1 / 2 " ~}[71.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$.

Rearrange sts as follows:
Slip first 9 sts from 2nd needle, onto end of 1st needle. Slip 2 sts from end of 3 rd needle, onto beg of 1st needle. There are now $31(35,35)$ sts on 1st needle.
Divide rem $32(35,35)$ sts from 2nd and 3 rd needles onto 2 needles and
leave for instep.

## Heel:

Join yarn to end of 1st needle and proceed as follows:
Row 1: (WS). Purl.
Row 2: *K. SliK. Rep from * to last st. KI.
Row 3: K1. Purl to last st. K1.
Rep last 2 rows until heel measures $2^{1 / 21}$ " [6 cm], ending on 2nd row.

## Shape heel:

Row 1: P15 (17, 17). P2tog. P1. Turn.
Row 2: K3. Slı. K1. psso. K1. Turn.
Row 3: P4. P2tog. Pı. Turn.
Row 4: K5. Slı. K1. psso. K. Turn.
Row 5: P6. P2tog. Pı. Turn.
Row 6: K7. Slı. K1. psso. K1. Turn.
Row 7: P8. P2tog. Pı. Turn.
Row 8: K9. Slı. Kı. psso. Kı. Turn.
Row 9: Plo. P2tog. P1. Turn.
Row 10: K11. Slı. K1. psso. K1. Turn.
Row 11: P12. P2tog. P1. Turn.
Row 12: K13. Sl1. K1. psso. K1. Turn.
Row 13: P14. P2tog. Pı. Turn.

## Size S only:

Row 14: K15. Sl1. K1. psso. Turn.
Row 15: P15. P2tog. 16 sts.

## Sizes $M$ and $L$ only:

Row 14: K15. St1. K7. psso. K1. Turn.
Row 15: P16. P2tog. P1. Turn.
Row 16: K17. Sl1. K7. psso. Turn.
Row 17: P17. P2tog. 18 sts.

## All Sizes, shape instep:

With RS of work facing and 1st needle, pick up and knit 21 sts along left side of heel.
With 2nd needle, K2. Work across 28 $(35,35)$ sts in Lace pat. K2.
With 3rd needle, pick up and knit 31 sts along right side of heel. Knit first $8(\mathbf{9}, 9)$ sts from heel onto end of 3 rd needle. Slip rem $8(\mathbf{9}, 9)$ sts from heel onto beg of ist needle.
$90(95,95)$ sts are now divided as:
$29(\mathbf{3 0}, 30)$ sts on 1st needle, 32 ( $\mathbf{3 5}$,
$35)$ sts on 2nd needle, and $29(30,30)$ sts on 3 rd needle.
Rnd 1: 1st needle, Knit to last 3 sts.
K2tog. K1. 2nd needle, K2 (0, 0). Work next $28(\mathbf{3 5}, \mathbf{3 5})$ sts in Lace pat. K2 ( $\mathbf{0}$, O). 3rd needle, K1. SliK. K7. psso. Knit to end of needle.
Rnd 2: 1st needle, Knit. 2nd needle, K2 ( $\mathbf{0}, \mathrm{O}$ ). Work pat to last 2 sts. K2 ( $\mathbf{O}$, ○). 3rd needle, Knit.
Rep last 2 rnds until there are 64 ( $\mathbf{7}$,
7) sts divided as:
$16(\mathbf{1 8}, 18)$ sts on 1st needle, $32(\mathbf{3 5}, 35)$
sts on 2nd needle, and $16(\mathbf{1 8}, 18)$ sts
on 3rd needle.
Cont even, working 2nd needle, in
pat, until foot from picked up sts at
heel measures $5(\mathbf{6}, 61 / 2)$ " $[12.5(15,16.5)$
$\mathrm{cm}]$, at beg of last rnd. $64(70,70)$ sts.
There are now $16(17,17)$ sts on 1st
needle, $32(\mathbf{3 5}, \mathbf{3 5 )}$ sts on 2nd needle, $16(\mathbf{1 8}, 18)$ sts on 3 rd needle.

## Shape toe:

Rnd 1: 1st needle, Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 2nd needle, K1. Sl7. K7. psso. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 3rd needle, K1. SliK. K7. psso. Knit to end of needle.
Rnd 2: Knit.
Rep last 2 rnds until there are 20 (22, 22) sts divided as 5 sts on 1st needle, 10 ( $\mathbf{1 1}, 11$ ) sts on 2nd needle, and 5 ( $\mathbf{6}$, 6) sts on 3rd needle. Divide sts evenly onto 2 needles. Graft 2 sets of 10 ( $\mathbf{1 1}, 71$ ) sts tog for toe. Block on sock blockers or press lightly on WS using damp cloth.

STITCH GLOSSARY
Garter St = knit every row. (Rnds - knit 1 rnd, purl 1 rnd.)
Stockinette st = (Rows) knit on RS, purl on WS. (Rnds - knit every rnd.)
Reverse stockinette st = (Rows) purl on RS, knit on WS. (Rnds - purl every rnd.)
