Yarn Requirements:

Sugar Bush Itty-Bitty (shown in 5001 Buttercream)				
balls	10	11	12	13

Knitting Needle Requirements:

US 2 (2.75 mm) and US 3 (3.25 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

Abbreviations: see page 4

Materials:

Stitch holders, Yarn needle

Gauge:

7 sts and 9 rows = 1" [2.5 cm] with larger needles in stockinette st.

Stitch Glossary:

M1 = Make 1 st by picking up horizontal loop lying before next st and working into back of it.

Ssk = Slip next 2 sts one at the time knitwise onto right-hand needle. Put point of left-hand needle through front of these sts and knit them together.

When worked between a purl then a knit stitch it is called **Yarn on needle** (yon). When worked between 2 purl stitches it is called **Yarn round needle** (yrn).

p2sso = Pass 2 slipped stitches over.

INSTRUCTIONS

Panel pattern: worked over 9 sts.

Row 1: (RS). P3. (K1. yfwd) twice. K1. P3.

Row 2: K3. P5. K3.

Row 3: P3. K2. yfwd. K1. yfwd. K2. P3.

Row 4: K3. P7. K3.

Row 5: P3. ssk. K1. (yfwd. K1) twice.

K2tog. P3.

Row 6: As Row 4.

Row 7: P3. ssk. K3. K2tog. P3.

Row 8: As Row 2.

Row 9: P3. ssk. K1. K2tog. P3.

Row 10: K3. P3. K3.

Row 11: P3. Yon. Sl2. K1. p2sso. Yrn. P3.

Row 12: As Row 10.

These 12 rows complete one pat.

BACK

With smaller needles, cast on 124 (132, 138, 146) sts, and work 11 rows in stockinette st.

Next row: Knit (this row forms ridge for hemline).

SHOP KIT

Change to larger needles and starting with knit row, cont in stockinette st until work from hemline measures 3" [7.5 cm], ending with RS facing for next row.

Next row: K10 (11, 12, 13). K2togtbl.

Knit to last 12 (13, 14, 15) sts. K2tog.

Knit to end of row.

Work 11 rows in stockinette st.

Rep last 12 rows to 116 (124, 130, 138) sts.

Cont in stockinette st until work from ridge for hemline measures 16" [41 cm], ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armholes:

Cast off 4 sts beg next 2 rows.

Dec 1 st each end of needle, every row to 100 (108, 114, 122) sts, then next and every alt row to 84 (88, 92, 96) sts rem.

Cont even until work from beg measures 24 (24 1/2, 25, 25 1/2)" [61 (62, 64, 65) cm], ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulders:

Cast off 7 (8, 8, 8) sts beg next 4 rows, then 8 (7, 8, 9) sts beg next 2 rows.

Cast off rem sts.

LEFT FRONT

To make pocket piece:

With larger needles, cast on 32

(33, 34, 35) sts and work 40 rows in stockinette st.

Leave these sts on st holder.

With smaller needles, cast on 58 (62, 66, 70) sts and work 11 rows in stockinette st.

Next row: Knit (this row forms ridge for hemline).

Change to larger needles and starting with knit row, work 12 rows in stockinette st.

Place Panel pat as follows:

Row 1: Knit to last 9 sts. Work 1 st row of Panel pat as given at beg of instructions.

Row 2: Work 2nd row of Panel pat. Purl to end of row.

Beg with 3rd row of Panel pat and keeping rem sts in stockinette st, cont until work from hemline measures 3" [7.5 cm], ending with RS facing for next row.

Next row: K10 (11, 12, 12). K2togtbl.

Knit to last 9 sts. Pat 9.

Work 11 rows.

Rep last 12 rows once.

Next row: K10 (11, 12, 13). K2togtbl. K3 (5, 7, 9). Leave next 32 (33, 34, 35) sts on a st holder to be worked later for pocket edge. Knit across sts of pocket piece. Work to end of row. Work 11 rows.

Next row: K10 (11, 12, 13). K2togtbl.

Work to end of row.

Keep cont of Panel pat, cont even until work measures 20 rows less than Back to start of armhole shaping, end with RS facing for next row.

Shape front:

Next row: Knit to last 11 sts. K2tog.

Pat 9.

Work 3 rows even.

Rep last 4 rows to 49 (53, 57, 61) sts.

Work 3 rows even.

Shape armhole and front:

Cast off 4 sts. Knit to last 11 sts. K2tog. Pat 9.

Work 1 row even.

Dec 1 st at armhole edge on next then every row, at the same time dec 1 st at front edge as before on 5th, then every following 6th row to 38 (42, 46, 50) sts.

Work 1 row even.

Dec 1 st at armhole edge on next then every alt row, at the same time dec 1 st at front edge as before to 29 (30, 33, 34) sts.

Keeping armhole edge even, cont dec at front edge to 22 (23, 24, 25) sts.

Cont even until work measures same length as Back to shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

SHOP KIT

Shape shoulder:

Cast off 7 (**8, 8, 8**) sts, beg next and following alt row.
Work 1 row even.
Cast off rem sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Work exactly as given for Left Front to placing Panel pat.

Place Panel pat as follows:

Row 1: Work 1st row of Panel pat. Knit to end of row.

Row 2: Purl to last 9 sts. Work 2nd row of Panel pat.

Beg with 3rd row of Panel pat and keeping rem sts in stockinette st cont until work from ridge for hemline measures 3" [7.5 cm], ending with RS facing for next row.

Next row: Pat 9. Knit to last 12 (**13, 14, 15**) sts. K2tog. Knit to end of row.

Work 11 rows.

Rep last 12 rows once.

Next row: Pat 9. Leave next 32 (**33, 34, 35**) sts on st holder to be worked later for pocket edge. Knit across sts of pocket piece. K3 (**5, 7, 9**). K2tog. Knit to end of row.

Cont to correspond to Left Front, reversing all shaping.

SLEEVES

With smaller needles, cast on 56 (**58, 60, 62**) sts and work 2½" [6 cm] in (K1, P1) ribbing.

Next row: Rib 3 (**4, 5, 6**) sts. M1. (Rib 7. M1) 7 times. Rib to end of row. 64 (**66, 68, 70**) sts.

Change to larger needles and cont in stockinette st, inc 1 st each end of needle on 9th (**10th, 13th, 5th**) row then every following 10th (**10th, 8th, 8th**) row to 86 (**90, 94, 98**) sts. Cont even in stockinette st until sleeve from beg measures 17" [43 cm], ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape top:

Cast off 4 sts beg next 2 rows.

Size L and XL only:

Work 2 rows even.

All Sizes:

Dec 1 st at each end of needle on next, then every alt row to 26 sts.

Work 1 row even.

Cast off rem sts.

FINISHING

Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves. Fold hem at ridge to WS and sew loosely in position.

Pocket edge:

With RS of work facing and smallest needles knit across sts on st holder. Starting with Purl row, work 6 rows in stockinette st.

Next row: Knit.

Starting with a knit row, work 6 rows stockinette st.

Cast off.

Fold pocket edge at ridge to WS and sew loosely in position. Sew pocket edge in position on RS and pocket piece in position on WS.

Front band:

With smaller needles cast on 11 sts.

Row 1: K2. *P1. K1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

Row 2: K1. *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.

Rep these 2 rows until band fits up left front to centre back of neck.

Cast off in ribbing. Work another band the same. Sew cast off ends of bands together at centre back. Sew band in position. Pin to measurements and steam lightly through a damp cloth.

STITCH GLOSSARY

- Garner St = knit every row. (Rnds – knit 1 rnd, purl 1 rnd.)
- Stockinette st = (Rows) knit on RS, purl on WS. (Rnds – knit every rnd.)
- Reverse stockinette st = (Rows) purl on RS, knit on WS. (Rnds – purl every rnd.)
