

SHOP KIT



4/Walk in the Park Set

Sizes:

Cap: One size to fit average adult.

Scarf: Approx 9" wide x 64" long [23 cm wide x 162.5 cm long]

Socks: **S** **M** **L**

Finished Foot Length:

inches	9"	9 1/2"	10 1/2"
cm	23	24	26.5

Yarn Requirements: Sugar Bush Itty-Bitty (shown with Main Colour (MC) in 5008 Indigo, Contrast A in 5002 Granite, Contrast B in 5009 Sunglow)

MC	8	8	9	balls
A	2	2	2	balls
B	1	1	1	ball

Knitting Needle Requirements:

Set of 4 US 2 (2.75 mm) double-pointed needles for sock and cap.
Set of 4 US 3 (3.25 mm) double-pointed needles for cap. Pair of US 3 (3.25 mm) needles for scarf **or size needed to obtain gauge**

Abbreviations: see page 4

Materials:

Sock blocks, Stitch markers

Gauge:

Socks – 30 sts and 44 rows = 4" [10 cm] with smaller needles in stockinette st.

Cap or scarf – 28 sts and 36 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in stockinette st.

INSTRUCTIONS

SOCKS

With A, cast on 68 sts loosely. Divide sts into 18 sts on 1st needle, 32 sts on 2nd needle, and 18 sts on 3rd needle, join in rnd, placing marker on 1st st.

**Work 4 rnds in (K2. P2) ribbing.

With MC, work 4 rnds in (K2. P2) ribbing.

With B, work 4 rnds in ribbing.

With MC, work 4 rnds in ribbing.

Rep last 16 rnds once more.

With A, work 4 rnds in ribbing.**

With MC, knit in rnds until work from

beg measures 7 1/2" [19 cm].

Heel:

Divide 32 sts on 2nd needle onto 2 needles and leave for instep.

Knit 18 sts off 1st needle onto end of 3rd needle, 36 sts for heel.

Next row: (WS). K1. P16. P2tog. P16. K1. 35 sts. Break MC.

Next row: With A, *K1. Sl. Rep from * to last st. K1.

Next row: Purl.

With A, rep last 2 rows until heel measures 2 1/2" [6 cm] , ending with WS facing for next row.



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Shape heel:

Row 1: K1. P17. P2tog. P1. Turn.

Row 2: K3. Sl1. K1. pssso. K1. Turn.

Row 3: P4. P2tog. P1. Turn.

Row 4: K5. Sl1. K1. pssso. K1. Turn.

Row 5: P6. P2tog. P1. Turn.

Row 6: K7. Sl1. K1. pssso. K1. Turn.

Row 7: P8. P2tog. P1. Turn.

Row 8: K9. Sl1. K1. pssso. K1. Turn.

Row 9: P10. P2tog. P1. Turn.

Row 10: K11. Sl1. K1. pssso. K1. Turn.

Row 11: P12. P2tog. P1. Turn.

Row 12: K13. Sl1. K1. pssso. K1. Turn.

Row 13: P14. P2tog. P1. Turn.

Row 14: K15. Sl1. K1. pssso. K1. Turn.

Row 15: P16. P2tog. P1. Turn.

Row 16: K17. Sl1. K1. pssso. K1. 19 sts.

Break A.

Shape instep:

With RS of work facing, MC and 1st needle, pick up and knit 18 sts along left side of heel.

With 2nd needle, knit across 32 sts for instep.

With 3rd needle, pick up and knit 18 sts along right side of heel.

Knit first 10 sts from heel onto end of 3rd needle. Slip rem 9 sts from heel onto beg of 1st needle, 32 sts on second needle, and 28 sts on 3rd needle.

Rnd 1: 1st needle, Knit to last 4 sts.

K2tog. K2. 2nd needle, Knit. 3rd needle, K2. Sl1. K1. pssso. Knit to end of needle.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rep last 2 rnds until there are 63 sts divided as 15 sts on 1st needle, 32 sts on 2nd needle, and 16 sts on 3rd needle.

Cont even until foot from pick up sts at heel measures 5½ (6, 7)" [14 (15, 18) cm].

Next rnd: Knit, dec 1 st at centre. 62 sts.

Shape toe: With A.

Rnd 1: 1st needle, Knit to last 3 sts.

K2tog. K1. 2nd needle, K1. Sl1. pssso.

Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 3rd needle, K1. Sl1. K1. pssso. Knit to end of round.

Rnd 2: Knit.

With A, rep last 2 rounds until there are 18 sts divided as 5 sts on 1st needle, 9 sts on 2nd needle, and 4 sts on 3rd needle. Slip sts on 1st needle onto 3rd needle.

With A, graft 2 sets of 9 sts tog for toe. Block on sock blockers or press lightly on WS with a damp cloth.

CAP

With A and set of 4 smaller needles, cast on 132 sts loosely.

Divide sts into 44 sts on each of 3

needles, join in round, placing marker on first st.

Work from ** to ** as given for socks.

Change to set of 4 larger needles, and knit in rounds until work from beg measures 7" [18 cm].

Shape crown:

Rnd 1: K14. *K2tog. K2. Sl1. K1. pssso.

K27. Rep from * twice more. K2tog.

K2. Sl1. K1. pssso. K13.

Rnd 2 and alt rounds: Knit.

Rnd 3: K13. *K2tog. K2. Sl1. K1. pssso.

K25. Rep from * twice more. K2tog.

K2. Sl1. K1. pssso. K12.

Rnd 5: K12. *K2tog. K2. Sl1. K1. pssso.

K23. Rep from * twice more. K2tog.

K2. Sl1. K1. pssso. K11.

Cont in this manner, dec 8 sts evenly around every following alt rnd until there are 20 sts.

Break yarn leaving a long end.

Draw end through rem sts tightly and fasten securely.

SCARF

With A, cast on 72 sts.

Row 1: (RS). K2. *P2. K4. Rep from * to last 4 sts. P2. K2.

Row 2: P2. *K2. P4. Rep from * to last 4 sts. K2. P2.

These 2 rows form rib pat.

Rep last 2 rows once more.

With MC, work 4 rows in rib pat.

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With B, work 4 rows in rib pat.

With MC, work 4 rows in rib pat.

Rep last 16 rows once more.

With A, work 4 rows in rib pat until work from beg measures 61" [155 cm], ending on 2nd row.

With A, work 4 rows in rib pat.

With MC, work 4 rows in rib pat.

With B work 4 rows in rib pat.

With MC, work 4 rows in rib pat.

Rep last 16 rows once more.

With A, work 4 rows in rib pat.

Cast off in ribbing.

STITCH GLOSSARY

- Garner St = knit every row. (Rnds – knit 1 rnd, purl 1 rnd.)
- Stockinette st = (Rows) knit on RS, purl on WS. (Rnds – knit every rnd.)
- Reverse stockinette st = (Rows) purl on RS, knit on WS. (Rnds – purl every rnd.)
