

## LILY $^{\circledR}$ SUGAR'N CREAM ${ }^{\circledR}$ <br> MOBILE PHONE COVERS <br> (TO CROCHET)

## MEASUREMENTS

To fit device approx $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}[6 \times 11.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$.

## MATERIALS

Lily ${ }^{\circledR}$ Sugar'n Cream ${ }^{\circledR}$ (70.9 g/2.5 oz; $109 \mathrm{~m} / 120$ yds) Version 1

## Contrast A

Warm Brown (01130) 15 m/16.5 yds or 1 ball
Contrast B
Hot Blue (01742)
$5.5 \mathrm{~m} / 6 \mathrm{yds}$ or 1 ball
Contrast C
Tangerine (01699)
Contrast D
Hot Green (01712) $\quad 5.5$ m/6 yds or 1 ball
Note: 1 ball each of $A, B, C$ and $D$ will make 8 Covers.

## Version 2

Contrast A
Sage Green (00084)
$5.5 \mathrm{~m} / 6$ yds or 1 ball
Contrast B
Warm Brown (01130) 5.5 m/6 yds or 1 ball
Contrast C
Hot Green (01712)
$5.5 \mathrm{~m} / 6 \mathrm{yds}$ or 1 ball
Contrast D
Hot Blue (01742) $\quad \mathbf{1 8 . 5} \mathbf{~ m / 2 0 ~ y d s ~ o r ~} 1$ ball
Note: 1 ball each of $A, B, C$ and $D$ will make 6 Covers.

Size 3.75 mm (U.S. F or 5) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. 1 button.

INSTRUCTIONS
VERSION 1
**With A, ch 14.
1st rnd: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. (Ch 1. Miss next ch. 1 sc in next ch) 5 times. Ch 1. Miss next ch. (1 sc. Ch 1) twice in last ch. Working across opposite side of foundation ch, (miss next ch. 1 sc in next ch. Ch 1) 5 times. 1 sc in last ch. Ch 1. Join with sl st to first sc. 28 sts.
2nd rnd: SI st in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1.1 sc in same sp. *Ch 1 . Miss next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * around, ending with ch 1. Miss last sc. Join with sl st to first sc. Fasten off.**
3rd rnd: Join B with sl st in last ch-1 sp of previous rnd. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp. *Ch 1 . Miss next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * around, ending with ch 1 . Miss last sc. Join with sl st to first sc.
4th rnd: As 2nd rnd. Fasten off.
5th and 6th rnds: With C , as 3rd and 4th rnds.
7th and 8th rnds: With A, as 3rd and 4th rnds.
9th and 10th rnds: With D, as 3rd and 4th rnds.
11th and 12th rnds: With A, as 3rd and 4th rnds.
13th and 14th rnds: With C, as 3rd and 4th rnds.
15th and 16th rnds: With B, as 3rd and 4th rnds.
17th and 18th rnds: With $A$, as 3rd and 4th rnds. Do not fasten off $A$. 19th rnd: With $A$, as $2 n d$ rnd.
20th rnd: With $D$, as 3rd rnd. Do not fasten off.
Cont as follows for button loop: With D, sl st across each st and ch-1 sp to center back of last rnd. Ch 24 (button loop). Join with sl st in center back. Fasten off.
Sew button to front to correspond to button loop.

## VERSION 2

Work from ${ }^{* *}$ to ** as given for Version 1.
3rd rnd: Join B with sl st in last ch-1 sp of previous rnd. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp. *Ch 1 . Miss next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * around, ending with ch 1 . Miss last sc. Join with sl st to first sc.
4th rnd: As 2nd rnd.
5th and 6th rnds: With C , as 3rd and 4th rnds.
7th and 8th rnds: With $A$, as 3 rd and 4th rnds.
9th and 10th rnds: With B, as 3rd and 4th rnds.
11th to 14th rnds: With $D$, as 3rd and 4th rnds twice.
15th and 16th rnds: With $C$, as 3 rd and 4th rnds.
17th to 20th rnds: With D, as 3rd and 4th rnds twice. Do not fasten off.
Cont as follows for button loop: With D, sl st across each st and ch-1 sp to center back of last rnd. Ch 24 (button loop). Join with sl st in center back. Fasten off.
Sew button to front to correspond to button loop.

## GAUGE

15 sc and 16 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].
