## INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Join all rnds with sl st to first st.

## BACKGROUND

With A, ch 83.
1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 82 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Rep 2nd row until work from beg measures 37 " $[94 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].
Fasten off.

## Edging

1st rnd: (RS). Join B with sl st in top left corner. Ch 1 .Work 1 rnd sc evenly around Background, working 3 sc in each corner. Join. Do not fasten off. Turn.

## Dowel Casing

1st row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc across top of Background Edging. Turn. 85 sc.

Rep 1st row until Dowel Casing measures 3" $[7.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$.
Fasten off.
Fold Dowel Casing in half lengthwise. Sew final row to WS to form casing to insert dowel.

POCKETS (make 4 each in C, D, E, F, G, and H)

Ch 9.
1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 8 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Rep 2nd row until work from beg measures 3 " $[7.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$.
Fasten off.

With A, using chain st, embroider numbers 1-24 on Pockets according to diagram (see page 7).

## Chain Stitch



Beg $11 / 4$ " $[2.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] up from bottom and 1" [ 2.5 cm ] from side, sew 3 edges of Pockets onto Background following diagram for placement and leaving 1" [ 2.5 cm ] between Pockets.

## WREATH

With D, ch 70. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring.
1st rnd: Ch 2.1 hdc in each ch around. Join. 70 hdc .
2nd rnd: Ch 2. *1 hdc in each of next 6 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Break D. Join C. 80 hdc.
3rd rnd: With C, ch 2. *1 hdc in each of next 7 hdc .2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 90 hdc .
4th rnd: Ch 2. *1 hdc in each of next 8 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 100 hdc .
5th rnd: Ch 2. *1 hdc in each of next 9 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 110 hdc.
6th rnd: Ch 2. *1 hdc in each of next 10 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 120 hdc.
7th rnd: Ch 2. *1 hdc in each of next 11 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 130 hdc .
8th rnd: Ch 2. *1 hdc in each of next 12 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 140 hdc .

9th rnd: Ch 2. *1 hdc in each of next 13 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 150 hdc .
10th rnd: Ch 2. *1 hdc in each of next 14 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 160 hdc.
11th rnd: Ch 2. *1 hdc in each of next 15 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 170 hdc.
12th rnd: Ch 2. *1 hdc in each of next 16 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 180 hdc.
13th rnd: Ch 2.*1 hdc in each of next 17 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Break C. Join D. 190 hdc.
14th rnd: With D, ch 2. *1 hdc in each of next 18 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join. 200 hdc .
15th rnd: Skip first 2 hdc . ${ }^{*} \mathrm{dc}$ in next hdc. Skip next hdc. Sl st in each of next 2 hdc. Skip next hdc. Rep from * to last 3 hdc .5 dc in next hdc. Skip next hdc. SI st in last hdc. Join. Fasten off.

Sew Wreath to Background as shown in photo.

## Bow: With F, ch 14.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 13 sc .

2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Rep 2nd row until work from beg measures 16 " $[40.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$.
Fasten off.
Fold Bow in half widthwise. Sew ends tog.

Bow Center: With F, ch 6.
1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 5 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Rep 2nd row until work from beg measures 4 " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$.
Fasten off.
Center Bow seam in back of work. Wrap Bow Center around middle of Bow, covering Bow seam. Sew ends of Bow Center tog.

Sew Bow to top of Bow Ends as shown in photo.

## ORNAMENTS



CUPCAKE (make 1 of each Version):
Version 1: Use I as Color 1, A as
Color 2, F as Color 3, and L as Color 4.
Version 2: Use M as Color 1, A as
Color 2, F as Color 3, and K as Color 4. Note: See diagrams on page 9.

Icing: With Color 1, ch 2.
Bow Ends (make 2 alike): With F, ch 14.
1st row: 1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. Turn. 13 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Rep 2nd row until work from beg measures 6" [15 cm]. Fasten off.

Gather tops of Bow Ends with gathering stitch and sew to top of Wreath as shown in photo.

1st row: (RS). 4 sc in $2 n d$ ch from hook. Turn. 4 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.2 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn. 8 sc .
3rd row: Ch 1. *1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. 12 sc .
Do not fasten off. Do not turn.

Next row: (RS). Working along straight edge of Icing, ch 1 . Work 7 sc evenly across edge. Turn.

## Straight Stitch

Next row: Ch 1.Working in back loops only, *3 sc in next sc. Sl st in next sc. Rep from * to last sc. ( 3 sc . SI st) all in last sc. Fasten off.

Cupcake Bottom: With Color 2, ch 7. 1st row: Sl st in 2 nd ch from hook. Sl st in each of next 2 ch .1 sc in each of next 3 ch . Turn. 6 sts.
2nd row: Ch 1. Working in back loops only, 1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Sl st in each of next 3 sts. Turn.
3rd row: Ch 1. Working in back loops only, sl st in each of next 3 sl st. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Turn.
Rep 2nd and 3rd rows twice more.

## Fasten off.

Sew wider side edge of Cupcake Bottom to front loops of 2nd last row of lcing.

Cherry: With Color 3, ch 2.
1st rnd: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join. Ch 10 for hanging loop. Join to last sl st worked. Fasten off. Sew Cherry to top of Icing.
With Color 4, embroider Sprinkles with straight st as shown in photo.


PINEAPPLE (make 2)
Note: See diagram on page 9. With J, ch 4.
1st row: (WS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 2 ch . Turn. 3 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1. (1 sc. Ch 2.1 sc ) all in first sc. Ch 2.1 sc in next sc. Ch 2. ( 1 sc . Ch 2.1 sc ) all in last sc. Turn. 3rd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row, pushing each ch-2 to front of work. Turn. 5 sc.
4th row: Ch $1 .(1 \mathrm{sc} . \mathrm{Ch} 2.1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) all in first sc. *Ch 2.1 sc in next sc. Rep from * twice more. Ch 2. (1 sc. Ch 2. 1 sc ) all in last sc. Turn.

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5th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row, pushing each ch- 2 to front of work. Turn. 7 sc.
6th row: Ch 1. *1 sc in next sc. Ch 2. Rep from * to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.
7th row: As 5th row.
8th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. (Ch 2.1 sc in next sc) 3 times. Ch 2. Sc2tog. Turn. 9th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row, pushing each ch-2 to front of work. Break J. Join C.
10th row: With C, ch 4.1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 2 ch .1 sc in first sc of previous row. Ch 5.1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 3 ch .1 sc in next sc of previous row. Ch 12 for hanging loop. 1 sc in 11 th ch from hook 1 sc in next ch. 1 sc in next sc of previous row. Ch 5.1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 3 ch .1 sc in next sc of previous row. Ch 4.1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 2 ch . Sl st in first sc of previous row. Fasten off.


CACTUS PLANT (make 1 of each version)
Version 1: Use D as Color 1 and E as Color 2.
Version 2: Use C as Color 1 and F as Color 2.
Note: See diagrams on page 9.
Cactus: With Color 1, ch 11.
1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to last ch. 4 sc in last ch. Working into opposite side of foundation ch, 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. 22 sc . Turn.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 9 sc .2 sc in each of next 2 sc . Ch 10 for hanging loop. Sl st in same st as last 2 sc . 2 sc in each of next 2 sc .1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Ch 7.1 hdc in 3 rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in next ch. 3 hdc in next ch. 1 hdc in each of next 2 ch . 1 sc in each of last 6 sc .
Fasten off

Flower: With Color 2, ch 2.
1st rnd: ( 1 sc .1 dc ) 4 times all in 2nd ch from hook. Join.
Fasten off.
Sew Flower to top of Cactus under Hanging Loop.


DONUT (make 1 of each version)
Version 1: Use N as Color 1, L as Color 2, J as Color 3.
Version 2: Use N as Color 1, E as Color 2, M as Color 3.
Note: See diagrams on page 9.
Donut: With Color 1, ch 6. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring.
1st rnd: 12 sc in ring. Join.
2nd rnd: Ch 1. ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 18 sc 3rd rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 2 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 24 sc .

4th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 3 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. Ch 10 for hanging loop. Sl st in last sl st. 30 sc .
Fasten off.
Icing: With Color 2, Ch 8. Join with sl st to first ch to form ring.
1st rnd: 16 sc in ring. Join. 16 sc.
2nd rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in next sc. (1 dc. 1 sc ) all in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 24 sts.
Fasten off. Sew Icing to Donut.
With Color 3, embroider Sprinkles with straight st as shown in photo.


## AVOCADO (make 2)

Note: See diagram on page 10.
With N, ch 2.
1st rnd: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join. 6 sc.

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2nd rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in each sc around. Break N. Join D. 12 sc.

3rd rnd: With D, ch 1. Working in back loops only, ${ }^{*} 1$ sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 18 sc.
4th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 2 sc . 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 24 sc.
5th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 6 sc. Turn. 6 sc.
6th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
7th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc . Sc2tog. Turn. 4 sts.
8th row: Ch 1. (Sc2tog) twice. Break D. Join C. Turn. Do not fasten off. 2 sc . Edging rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in first sc. Ch 10 for hanging loop. Sl st in same st as last sc. 1 sc in next sc. Work 29 sc evenly around edge of Avocado. Join. Fasten off.


MUSHROOM (make 1 of each version)

Version 1: Use G as Color 1 and $A$ as Color 2.
Version 2: Use F as Color 1 and $A$ as Color 2.
Note: See diagrams on page 10.
Mushroom Cap: With Color 1, ch 9.
1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each sc to end of ch. Turn. 8 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1.2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 6 sc . 2 sc in last sc. Turn. 10 sc .
3rd row: Ch 1. (Sc2tog) twice. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. (Sc2tog) twice. Turn. 6 sts.
4th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
5th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc . Sc2tog. Turn. 4 sts .
6th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.
7th row: Ch 1. (Sc2tog) twice. Do not turn. Do not fasten off. 2 sts.
Edging rnd: Ch 1. Cont around circumference of Mushroom Cap, working 22 sc evenly around to last sc of previous row. 1 sc in nextsc. Ch 10 for hanging loop. SI st in same st as last sc. 1 sc in next sc. Join. Fasten off.

Stem: With A, ch 6.
1st row: 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in next ch. 1 dc in next ch. 6 dc in last ch. Working into opposite side of foundation ch, 1 dc in next ch. 1 hdc in each of last 2 ch . Fasten off
Sew Stem to bottom of Mushroom Cap. Using A, embroider spots with straight st on Mushroom Cap as shown in photo.


NARWHAL (make 1 of each version)
Version 1: Use L as Color 1, A as Color 2, and N as Color 3.
Version 2: Use K as Color 1, A as Color 2, and N as Color 3.
Note: See diagrams on page 10.
Body: With Color 1, ch 2.
1st rnd: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join. 6 sc.
2nd rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in each sc around. Join. 12 sc .
3rd rnd: Ch 1. ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join. 18 sc

4th rnd: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc.* Rep from * to * once more. Ch 10 for hanging loop. SI st in same st as last sc. Rep from * to * around. Join. 24 sc .

Tail: Next row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 4 sc . Turn.
Next row: Ch 1. (Sc2tog) twice. Turn. 2 sts.
Next row: Ch 3. *(2 dc. Ch 2. Sl st) all in next st. Rep from * once more. Fasten off.

Tusk: With Color 2, ch 5.
1st row: Sl st in 2nd ch from hook. Sl st in next ch. 1 sc in each of last 2 ch. Fasten off.

Sew Tusk to Narwhal as shown in photo.

Flippers (make 2): With Color 1, ch 2. 1st row: 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Fasten off.

Using Color 3, embroider eyes and mouth with straight st on Narwhal as shown in photo.

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SLOTH (make 1 of each version)
Version 1: Use H as Color 1, A as Color 2, and N as Color 3.
Version 2: Use K as Color 1, A as Color 2, and N as Color 3.
Note: See diagrams on page 11.

Body:With Color 1, ch 2.
1st row: 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook.
Turn. 4 sc
2nd row: Ch 1.2 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn. 8 sc .
3rd row: Ch 1. *1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 12 sc .
4th row: Ch $1 .{ }^{*} 1$ sc in each of next 2 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. Do not turn. 18 sc.
Ch 1 . Work 7 sc evenly across straight edge of body. Fasten off.

Arms (make 2): With Color 1, ch 2. 1st rnd: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join.

Next row: Ch 6.1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 4 ch .1 sc in next sc of last rnd. Fasten off. Sew Arms to Body as shown in photo.

Head: With Color 1, ch 2.
1st rnd: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join. 6 sc.
2nd rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in next 5 sc. Do not join. 10 sc.
Fasten off.

Face: With Color 2, ch 4.
1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. 3 sc . Fasten off.
Sew Face to Head as shown on photo. Using Color 3, embroider eyes and nose with straight st as shown in photo.
Un-ply 6" [15 cm] of Color 2. Using 1 ply of yarn, embroider glints in eyes with straight st.

Sew ends of Arms tog at top to form hanging loop.


RAINBOW (make 2)
Note: See diagrams on page 11.
With H, ch 2.
1st row: 3 sc in 2 nd ch from hook. Break H. Join D. Turn. 3 sc.
2nd row: With D, ch 1.2 sc in each sc to end of row. Break D. Join J. Turn. 6 sc .
3rd row: With J, ch 1. *1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. Break J. Join G. Turn. 9 sc.
4th row: With G, ch 1.*1 sc in each of next 2 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from* to end of row. Break G. Join F. Turn. 12 sc . 5th row: With F, ch 1.1 sc in each of next 3 sc .2 sc in next sc . 1 sc in each of next 2 sc . Ch 10 for hanging loop. Sl st in same st as last sc. 1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc .2 sc in last sc. 15 sc . Fasten off.

Clouds (make 2 for each Rainbow): With A, ch 4.

1st rnd: 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in next sc. 3 sc in next sc. Working into opposite side of foundation ch, 1 sc in each of last 2 ch . Join. 8 sc .
2nd rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in each of next 2 sc . 1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in each of next 3 sc .1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in last sc. Join. Fasten off.
Sew Clouds to bottom of Rainbow as shown in photo.


ROBOT (make 1 of each version)
Version 1: Use F as Color 1, L as Color 2, and A as Color 3.
Version 2: Use H as Color 1, G as Color 2, and A as Color 3.
Note: See diagrams on page 11.

Head: With Color 1, ch 5.
1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 4 sc . 2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

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3rd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 2 sc . Ch 10 for hanging loop. SI st in same st as last sc. 1 sc in each of last 2 sc . Fasten off.

Body:With Color 1, ch 7.
1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 6 sc . 2nd to 5th rows: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Fasten off.

Sew Head to Body as shown in photo.
Arms and Legs (make 4 for each Robot): With Color 2, ch 6.
1st row: (3 sc. Sl st) all in 2nd ch from hook.
Fasten off.

Sew Arms and Legs to Body as shown in photo.
Using Color 3, embroider eyes with straight st on Head as shown in photo.


## FLAMINGO (make 2)

Note: See diagrams on page 12.
Body: With I, ch 4.
1st rnd: 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in next sc. 3 sc in next sc. Working into opposite side of foundation ch, 1 sc in each of last 2 ch . Join. 8 sc .
2nd rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in each of next 2 sc. 1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in each of next 3 sc. 1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in last sc. Join. 3rd rnd: Ch 1 . ( 1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc) twice. 1 sc in next sc. Ch 10 for hanging loop. Sl st in same st as last sc. 1 sc in next sc. 2 hdc in next sc. 1 dc in next sc. Ch 3.2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc .2 sc in last sc . Join.

Neck and Head: Next row: Skip first sc. Sl st in each of next 3 sc. Ch 7. 5 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 4 ch . Sl st in next sc of previous rnd.
Fasten off.

Beak: With N, ch 2.
1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Break N. Join A. Turn.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in next sc. Turn 3rd row: Ch 2. SI st in next sc. Fasten off.

Wing: With I, ch 2.
1st rnd: (4 sc. 1 dc. Ch 3.1 sc ) all in 2nd ch from hook. Join. Fasten off. Sew Wing to Body as shown in photo.

## Front Leg: With E, ch 7.

1st row: Sl st in 2nd ch from hook. Sl st in each ch to end of ch. Fasten off, Sew Front Leg to Body as shown in photo.

Back Leg: With E, ch 9.
1st row: Sl st in 2nd ch from hook. Sl st in each of next 2 ch . Skip next ch. Sl st in each ch to end of ch. Fasten off. Sew Back Leg to Body and Front Leg as shown in photo.
Using N, embroider eye with straight st on Head.

LLAMA (make 1 of each version)
Version 1: Use A as Color 1, E as Color 2, G as Color 3, and N as Color 4.
Version 2: Use A as Color 1, D as
Color 2, J as Color 3, and N as Color 4.
Note: See diagrams on page 12.
Body: With Color 1, ch 9.
1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 8 sc . 2nd and 3rd rows: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
4th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn. 7 sc .

Neck and Head: 5th row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 3 sc . Turn. 3 sc .
6th to 9th rows: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
10th row: Ch 3.1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in next ch. Sl st in next sc of previous row. Sl st in next sc. Ch 3.1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in next ch. Sl st in last sc of previous row. Fasten off.

Legs (make 2): With Color 1, ch 5.
1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook.
1 sc in each sc to end of ch. 4 sc .
Fasten off.
Sew Legs to Body as shown in photo.
Tail: With Color 1, ch 2.
1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Turn. 1 sc.
2nd row: Ch 1.1 sc in next sc. Fasten off.
Sew Tail to Body as shown in photo.
Blanket: With Color 2, ch 5.
1st row: 1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each sc to end of ch. Break Color 2. Join Color 3. Turn. 4 sc.
2nd row: With Color 3, ch 1.1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
3rd row: Ch 1.1 sc in each of next 2 sc . Ch 10 for hanging loop. SI st in same st as last sc. 1 sc in each of last 2 sc . Fasten off.
Sew Blanket to Llama as shown in photo.
Sew 24 buttons evenly spaced around Wreath. Place Ornaments into Pockets on Wreath. Hang ornaments from buttons after daily 'reveal.'
