



SCRUB CLEAN CROCHET BATH MITT | CROCHET



MATERIALS

Lily® Sugar n' Cream® Scrub Off™ (2.6 oz/75 g; 106 yds/97 m)

Spring Blue (90016) 1 Ball

Size U.S. I/9 (5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.





CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Beg = Begin(ning)

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue(ity)

Rem = Remain(ing)

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook

SI st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENTS

One size to fit adult.

GAUGE

13 sc and 16 rows = 4'' [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Ch 34.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of ch. 33 sts. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row 6 times more.

Shape thumb gusset: 1st row:

(RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 17 sts. 2 sc in each of next 2 sts. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

2nd, 4th, 6th, 8th, 10th and 12th rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 17 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

5th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 17 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each of next 4 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.





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7th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first **3rd row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in first st. 17 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each of next 6 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

9th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first in last st. Turn. 17 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each each st to end of row. Turn.

11th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first in last st. Turn. 17 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in each each st to end of row. Turn.

17 sts. Ch 2. Skip next 14 sts. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

14th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st or ch-1 sp to end of row. 33 sts. Cont even until work from beg

measures 8" [20.5 cm] ending with a WS row.

Shape top: 1st row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in first st. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 11 sts. Sc2tog. 1 sc in next st. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 11 sts. Sc2tog. 1 sc in last st. Turn.

Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 9 sts. Sc2tog. 1 sc in next st. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 9 sts. Sc2tog. 1 sc in last st. Turn.

Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 7 sts. Sc2tog. 1 sc in next st. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 7 sts. Sc2tog. 1 sc

4th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first st. of next 8 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 5 sts. Sc2tog. 1 sc in next st. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 5 sts. Sc2tog. 1 sc

5th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first st. of next 10 sts. 2 sc in next st. 1 sc in Sc2tog. 1 sc in each of next 3 sts. Sc2tog. 1 sc in next st. Sc2tog. 1 sc **13th row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first in each of next 3 sts. Sc2tog. 1 sc in last st. Fasten off. Sew side seam.

> **Thumb:** With RS facing, join yarn withslsttochsp.Ch1.1scineach of next 2 ch. 1 sc in each of next 14 sts. Join with sl st to first sc. 16 sc.

> Next rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. Rep last rnd 4 times more.

> Next rnd: Ch 1. (Sc2tog) 8 times. Join with sl st to first st. 8 sts.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first st. Next rnd: Ch 1. (Sc2tog) 4 times. 4 sts. Fasten off. Thread end through a tapestry needle and draw yarn through rem sts. Fasten securely.
