



UN-BEET-ABLE CROCHET CLOTH

MATERIALS

Lily® Sugar'n Cream® (2.5 oz/70.9 g; 120 yds/109 m)

Contrast A Wine (00015)

1 ball or 26 yds/24 m

Contrast B Hot Pink (01740)

1 ball or 10 yds/9 m

Contrast C Dark Pine (00016)

1 ball or 10 yds/9 m

Contrast D Hot Green (01712)

1 ball or 8 yds/7 m

Note: 1 ball of A, B, C and D will make 3 Dishcloths.

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Yarn needle.





CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continue(ity)

Dc = Double crochet

Dc3tog = (Yoh and draw up a loop in next stitch. Yoh and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.

Rem = Remain(ing)

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

SI st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 7" [18 cm] wide x 10" [25.5 cm] tall.

GAUGE

13 dc and 7 rows = 4'' [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

BEET

Notes:

- Ch 3 at beg of each rnd counts as dc.
- Join end of each rnd with sl st in 3rd ch of first ch-3.

With A, ch 8. See diagram on page 2.

**1st rnd: 2 dc in 4th ch from hook (counts as 3 dc). 1 dc in each of next 3 ch. 6 dc in last ch. Rotate work to cont working along opposite side of foundation ch: skip 1st ch (ch just worked into). 1 dc in each of next 3 ch. 3 dc in last ch. Join with sl st to top of ch-3. 18 dc.

2nd rnd: Ch 3. 1 dc in same st as last sl st. 2 dc in each of next 2 dc. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc. 2 dc in each of next 6 dc. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc. 2 dc in each of last 3 dc. Join. 30 dc.**

Fasten off.





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3rd rnd: Skip first 8 dc. Re-join A with sl st in 9th dc. Ch 3. *(1 dc in next dc. 2 dc in next dc) 6 times. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc. Rep from * once more, ending with 1 dc in each of last 2 dc. Join, 42 dc.

4th rnd: Ch 3. *(1 dc in each of next 2 dc. 2 dc in next dc) 6 times. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc. Rep from * once more, ending with 1 dc in each of last 2 dc. Join. 54 dc.

5th rnd: Ch 3. *(1 dc in each of next 3 dc. 2 dc in next dc) 6 times. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc. Rep from * once more ending with 1 dc in each of last 2 dc. Join. 66 dc.

Cont in rows as follows:

1st row: (RS). Skip first 15 sts. Join B with sl st in 16th st. Ch 1. Skip first st. (1 sc in each of next 4 dc. 2 sc in next dc) twice. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc. 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each of next 4 dc. (2 sc in next dc. 1 sc in each of next 4 dc) twice. Sl st in next sc. Fasten off leaving rem sts unworked. **Do not** Turn. 39 sts.

2nd row: (RS). Skip first 17 dc of last row. Re-join B with sl st in 18th dc. Ch 2. Skip first st. Dc3tog. Ch 2. Sl st in next st. Fasten off.


LEAVES (Make 1 each in C and D) Ch 8.

1st and 2nd rnds: Rep from ** to ** as for Beet.

3rd rnd: Ch 3. 2 dc in next dc. (1 dc in next dc. 2 dc in next dc) twice. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc. (1 dc in next dc. 2 dc in next dc) 3 times. Fasten off, leaving rem sts unworked.

FINISHING

Overlap and sew Leaves to top of Beet as shown in photo.



STITCH KEY

= chain (ch)

• = slip stitch (sl st)

= single crochet (sc)

= double crochet (dc)
