



MATERIALS

Lily® Sugar'n Cream® (2.5 oz/70.9 g; 120 yds/109 m)

Contrast A Warm Brown (01130)

1 ball or 17 yds/16 m

Contrast B Sage Green (00084)

1 ball or 34 yds/31 m

Contrast C Dark Pine (00016)

1 ball or 9 yds/8 m

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Black Anchor® embroidery floss. Susan Bates® Steel Yarn Needle.

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 8" [20.5 cm] wide x 9½" [24 cm] long.

GAUGE

13 sc and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Join all rnds with sl st to first st.

Pit (Make 2) See diagram on page 2.

With A, ch 2.

1st rnd: 8 sc in 2nd ch from ring. Join. 8 sc.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 16 sc.

3rd rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. *1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Join. 24 sc.

4th rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. *1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last 2 sc. 1 sc in each of last 2 sc. Join. 32 sc.

5th rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. *1 sc in each of next 3 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last 3 sc. 1 sc in each of last 3 sc. Break A. Join B. 40 sc.

Join Pits: With WS of Pits tog, align sts and proceed as follows:

6th rnd: With B, ch 1. *Working through back loops of both thicknesses*, work 1 rnd of sc evenly around to join pieces. Join.

7th rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. *1 sc in each of next 4 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last 4 sc. 1 sc in each of last 4 sc. 48 sc.



8th rnd: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. *1 sc in each of next 5 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last 5 sc. 1 sc in each of last 5 sc. Join. 56 sc.

9th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 1 hdc in each of next 4 sc. (2 dc in next sc. 1 dc in each of next 6 sc) 5 times. 2 dc in next dc. 1 hdc in each of next 4 sc. 1 sc in each of the next 2 sc. Sl st in each of next 8 sc. Join. 62 sts.

Beg working in rows:

1st row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 16 sts. 1 hdc in each of next 4 sts. (1 dc in each of next 2 sts. 2 dc in next dc) 4 times. 1 dc in each of next 2 dc. 1 hdc in each of next 4 sts. 1 sc in each of next 16 sts. sl st in next sc. **Turn.**

2nd row: Skip first sl st. Sl st in each of next 16 sts. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. 1 hdc in each of next 2 hdc. (1 dc in each of next 3 dc. 2 dc in next dc) 4 times. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc. 1 hdc in each of next 2 sts. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. Sl st in next st. **Turn.**

3rd row: Skip first sl st. Sl st in each of next 6. 1 sc in each of next 2 sts. 1 hdc in each of next 4 sts. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc. 2 dc in next dc. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc. 1 hdc in

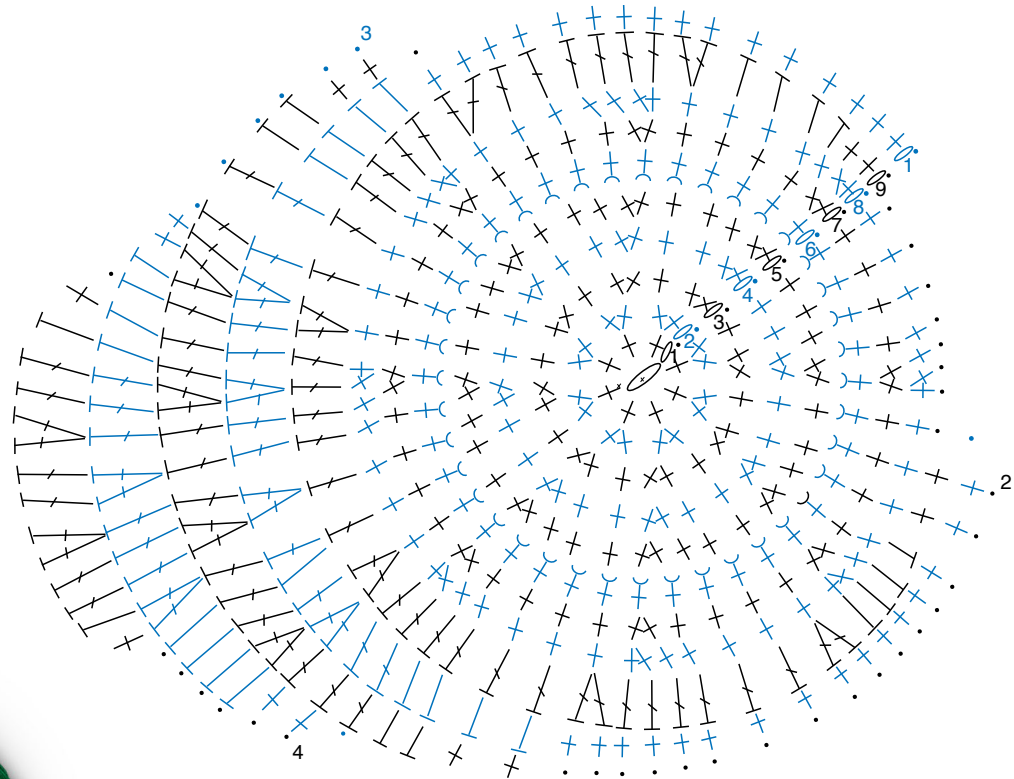
each of next 4 sts. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Sl st in next st. **Turn.**

4th row: Skip first sl st. Sl st in each of next 6 sts. 1 sc in next st. 1 hdc in next st. (1 dc in each of next 2 sts. 2 dc in next st) twice. 1 dc in each of next 2 sts. 1 hdc in next st. 1 sc in next st. Sl st in next st. Fasten off.

Edging rnd: Join C with sl st to any sl st along bottom of Avocado. Ch 1. Work 1 rnd of sc evenly around, having 2 sc in top dc. Join.

Face

With black embroidery floss, embroider face as shown in picture.



STITCH KEY
