



MATERIALS

Lily® Sugar'n Cream™ (2.5 oz/70.9 g; 120 yds/109 m)

Set of 5 Ornaments

Contrast A Warm Brown (01130)	1 ball or 100 yds/91 m
Contrast B White (00001)	1 ball or 26 yds/23.5 m
Contrast C Red (00095)	1 ball or 20 yds/18 m
Contrast D Hot Green (01712)	1 ball or 5 yds/4.5 m
Contrast E Hot Blue (01742)	1 ball or 5 yds/4.5 m
Contrast F Hot Orange (01628)	1 ball or 5 yds/4.5 m

Sizes U.S. D/4 (3.5 mm) and U.S. G/6 (4 mm) crochet hooks **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 3½" x 5" [9 x 12.5 cm].

GAUGE

14 sc and 15 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger hook.

INSTRUCTIONS

Roof

With A and larger hook, ch 13.

1st row: (WS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 12 sc. Place marker on last st.

2nd row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to last 2 sts. Sc2tog. Turn.

Rep 2nd and 3rd rows 4 times more. 2 sts rem.

Next row: Ch 1. Sc2tog. Fasten off.

Roof edging: 1st rnd: (RS). With larger hook, join B with sl st in marked st. Work 12 sl st evenly across shaped side of rows (lower edge of Roof). Sl st up straight side to Point. Ch 14 for hanging loop and sl st back into same sp as last sl st. Sl st down foundation ch. Join with sl st to first sl st.

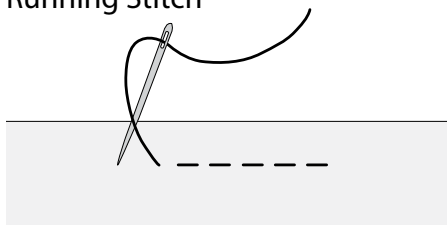
Change to smaller hook.

2nd rnd: Ch 1. Skip next sl st. *5 hdc in next sl st. Skip next sl st. Sl st in next sl st. Skip next sl st. Rep from * once more. 5 hdc in back loop of next sl st. Skip next sl st. Sl st in back loop of next sl st. Fasten off.

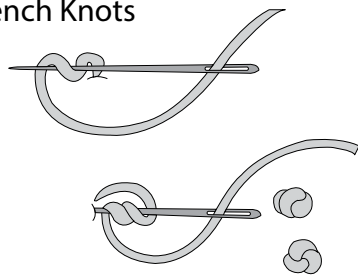


Roof Embroidery: With B, work running st embroidery across lower edges of 2nd, 4th, 6th, 8th and 10th rows. With C, D, E and F work French knots evenly spaced as shown between running st embroidery.

House

With A and larger hook, ch 13.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 12 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

Rep last row 6 times more (8 rows total). Fasten off.

House edging: With RS facing and larger hook, join B with sl st in top left corner. Sl st evenly down side, across foundation row and up opposite side to corner. Fasten off. Leave top edge unworked.

Heart

With C and smaller hook, ch 2.

1st row: (RS). 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Turn. 2 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. 4 sc.

3rd row: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. 6 sc.

First Hump: Next row: (WS).

Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. Sc2tog. Turn. 2 sc. Leave rem sts unworked.

Next row: Ch 1. Sc2tog.

Fasten off.

Second Hump: Next row: (WS).

Join C with sl st to next unworked sc. Ch 1. Sc2tog over same st as last sl st and next st. 1 sc in last st. Turn. 2 sc.

Next row: Ch 1. Sc2tog.

Fasten off.

Sew Heart in position as shown.

Sew Roof to House.
