## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 63/4" [17 cm] diameter x 612" [16.5 cm] high

## GAUGE

13 sc and 14 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].
Note: Gauge is important to ensure project matches purchased plant pot size.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Pot Cozy and Trim are worked separately and joined during assembly.

## POT COZY

Note: Do not join at ends of rnds (unless otherwise stated). Cont working in spiral placing marker on first st of rnd for easier counting.

With MC, ch 52. Join in rnd with sl st to first ch to form a ring, taking care not to twist chain.
1st rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in each ch around. 52 sts.
2nd rnd: Skip ch 1.1 sc in each sc around.
3rd rnd: 1 sc in each sc around.
4th rnd: ( 1 sc in each of next 16 sc . 2 sc in next sc) twice. 1 sc in each of next 17 sc .2 sc in next sc .55 sts . 5th to 7th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.
8th rnd: 1 sc in each of next 9 sc . ( 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 17 sc ) twice. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 9 sc .58 sts.
9th and 10th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.

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## LITTLE POTTED PLANT CROCHET COZY | CROCHET

11th rnd: 1 sc in each of next 19 sc .2 sc in next sc. ( 1 sc in each of next 18 sc .2 sc in next sc ) twice. 61 sts.
12th to 14th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.
15th rnd: 1 sc in each of next 10 sc . ( 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 19 sc ) twice. 2 sc in next sc . 1 sc in each of next 10 sc .64 sts.
16th and 17th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.
18th rnd: (1 sc in each of next 20 sc .2 sc in next sc) twice. 1 sc in each of next 21 sc .2 sc in next sc . 67 sts.
19th to 21st rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.
22nd rnd: 1 sc in each of next 11 sc. ( 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 21 sc ) twice. 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 11 sc .70 sts.
23rd rnd: 1 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc.
Fasten off.

## TRIM

With A, ch 72 (or a multiple of 4 that fits evenly around opening of Pot Cozy). Join with sl st to first ch, taking care not to twist chain.

1st rnd: (RS). Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 2 ch . Ch 3.1 sc in each of next 2 ch. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first sc. 72 sc .
2nd rnd: *Skip next 2 sc . ( 3 dc . Ch 2.3 dc ) in next ch-3 sp. Skip next 2 sc . Sl st in sp between 2nd and 3rd sc. Rep from * around, ending with sl st in last sl st from 1st rnd.
Fasten off.
Assembly: With RS facing, align foundation edge of Trim evenly around top edge of Pot Cozy. Join A with sl st to any foundation ch of Trim. With Trim on top of Pot Cozy and working through both thicknesses (foundation ch of Trim and front loop only of last rnd of Pot Cozy), work 1 rnd of sl st evenly around. Join with sl st to first sl st. Fasten off. SI st will form ridge on RS.
