Contrast A and C Blueberry (01725) $\mathbf{1}$ ball or 112 yds/ 102.5 m
Contrast B Ecru (00004) 1 ball or 94 yds/86 m

Contrast A Yellow (00010)
Contrast B White (00001)
Contrast C Hot Orange (01628)
1 ball or 94 yds/86 m
1 ball or 94 yds/86 m
1 ball or $18 \mathrm{yds} / 16.5 \mathrm{~m}$

## MEASUREMENT

Approx 9½" [24 cm] square.

## GAUGE

15 sts and 11 rows $=4$ " [10 cm $]$ in pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Notes:

Carry color not in use across top of row and work sts around it.
To join new color, work to last loops on hook, yoh with new color to complete st and proceed with new color.

With A, ch 36.
1 st row: (RS). With A, 1 sc in 2 nd ch from hook. (1 dc in next ch. 1 sc in next ch) twice, joining $B$ in last st. *With B, (1 dc in next ch. 1 sc in next ch) twice. 1 dc in next ch, joining $A$. With A, ( 1 sc in next ch. 1 dc in next ch) twice. 1 sc in next ch, joining B. Rep from * twice more, omitting joining $B$ at end of row. Turn. 35 sts. 2nd row: With $A$, ch 3 (counts as dc). (1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc) twice, joining B in last st. *With $B$, (1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc) twice. 1 sc in next dc, joining $A$. With $A$, ( 1 dc in next sc. 1 sc in next dc) twice. 1 dc in next sc, joining B. Rep from * twice more, omitting joining $B$ at end of row. Turn.

3rd row: With A, ch 1.1 sc in first dc. (1 dc in next sc. 1 sc in next dc) twice, joining $B$ in last st. *With B, (1 dc in next sc. 1 sc in next dc) twice. 1 dc in next sc, joining A. With A, (1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc) twice. 1 sc in next dc, joining B. Rep from * twice more, joining $B$ at end of row. Turn. 4th row: With B, ch 3 (counts as dc). ( 1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc) twice, joining A in last st. *With A, ( 1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc) twice. 1 sc in next dc, joining $B$. With B, (1 dc in next sc. 1 sc in next dc) twice. 1 dc in next sc, joining A. Rep from * twice more, omitting joining $A$ at end of row. Turn.
5th row: With B, ch 1.1 sc in first dc. (1 dc in next sc. 1 sc in next dc) twice, joining A in last st. *With A, ( 1 dc in next sc. 1 sc in next dc) twice. 1 dc in next sc, joining $B$. With B, (1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc) twice. 1 sc in next dc, joining $A$. Rep from * twice more, omitting joining $A$ at end of row. Turn.
6th row: As 4th row, joining $A$ at end of row.
7th row: As 3rd row.
Rep 2nd to 7th rows for pat until work from beg measures approx 9" [23 cm], ending on a 3rd row of pat. Fasten off.

Edging: 1st rnd: (RS). Join C with sl st in bottom left corner. Ch 1. Work 3 sc in same sp as last sl st. Work 33 sc across rem loops of foundation ch. Work 3 sc in next corner. Work 33 sc up side edge. Work 3 sc in next corner. Work 1 sc in each st across top edge. Work 3 sc in next corner. Work 33 sc down side edge. Join with sl st to first sc. Turn.

2nd rnd: (WS). Ch 1. Work 1 scfp around each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc. Ch 16 for loop. SI st back into each ch of loop. Fasten off leaving long end. Thread end onto yarn needle and join opposite end of loop into corner.
