CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately **Rep** = Repeat **Beg** = Beginning Rnd(s) = Round(s)Ch = Chain(s)**Sc** = Single crochet **Hdc** = Half double crochet **SI st** = Slip stitch

MEASUREMENT

Approx 4" [10 cm] diameter.

GAUGE

13 sc and 14 rows = 4'' [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Chain (ch) 2 at beginning (beg) of rounds (rnds) does not count as half double crochet (hdc).

COASTER

Make 1 each with B, C, D, and E as Color 2.

With A, ch 3.

1st rnd: 10 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. Join with slip stitch (sl st) to first hdc. 10 hdc.

2nd rnd: Ch 2. 2 hdc in each hdc around. Join with sl st to first hdc. 20 hdc.

3rd rnd: Ch 2. 1 hdc in first hdc. *2 hdc in next hdc. 1 hdc in next hdc. Repeat (rep) from * to last hdc. 2 hdc in last hdc. Join Color 2 with sl st to first hdc. 30 hdc.

4th rnd: With Color 2, ch 1. 1 single crochet (sc) in first hdc. 1 sc in next hdc. *2 sc in next hdc. 1 sc in each of next 2 hdc. Rep from * to last hdc. 2 sc in last hdc. Join A with sl st to first sc. 40 sc.

5th rnd: With A, ch 2. 1 hdc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first hdc.

Fasten off.

STITCH KEY

= chain (ch)

= slip stitch (sl st)

= single crochet (sc)

= half double crochet (hdc)

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.
