Size U.S. H/8 ( 5 mm ) Susan Bates ${ }^{\oplus}$ Silvalume ${ }^{\oplus}$ crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ yarn needle. Susan Bates ${ }^{\ominus}$ stitch marker.

## MEASUREMENTS

Coasters: Approx 4" [10 cm] diameter.
Plant Pot: Approx 3" [7.5 cm] diameter $\times 21 / 2 "[6 \mathrm{~cm}]$ tall when folded.

GAUGE
13 sc and 14 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ]

## INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Join each rnd with sl st to first sc.

## COASTERS

Center (Make 3 each with A and B.) See diagram on page 2.
Ch 2.
1st rnd: 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join. 8 sc.

2nd rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in same sp as sl st. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 16 sc.
3rd rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in same sp as sl st. *1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * 6 times more. 1 sc in last sc. Join. 24 sc.
4th rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in same sp as sl st. *1 sc in each of next 2 sc . 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * 6 times more. 1 sc in each of last 2 sc . Join. 32 sc . Fasten off.

Outer (Work with B on A Centers and $C$ on $B$ Centers)

Join corresponding color with sl st to back loop of any sc.

## Yarnspirations" <br> spark your inspiration!

1st rnd: Ch 1.2 scbl in same sp as sl st. ( 1 scbl in each of next 3 sc . 2 scbl in next sc) 7 times. 1 scbl in each of last 3 sc . Join. 40 sc .
2nd rnd: Ch 5. SI st in 2nd ch from hook and in each of next 3 ch - Stem made. 1 sc in first sc. 1 sl st in each of next 4 sc . *( 2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc ) twice. 2 hdc in next sc.** 1 hdc in each of next 2 sc . 1 dc in each of next 2 sc . ( 1 dc . Picot. 1 dc ) all in next sc. 1 dc in each of next 2 sc . 1 hdc in each of next 2 sc . 2 hdc in next sc. Rep from * to ** once more. 1 sl st in each of last 4 sc . Join. Fasten off.

## PLANT POT

With D, ch 2.
1st rnd: 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join. 8 sc .
2nd rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in same sp as sl st. 2 sc in each sc around. Join. 16 sc.
3rd rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in same sp as sl st. (1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc) 7 times. 1 sc in last sc. Join. 24 sc .
4th rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in same sp as sl st. (1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc) 7 times. 1 sc in each of last 2 sc . Join. 32 sc .

5th rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in same sp as sl st. ( 1 sc in each of next 3 sc . 2 sc in next sc) 7 times. 1 sc in each of last 3 sc . Join. PM at end of rnd. 40 sc .
6th rnd: Ch 1.1 scbl in each sc around. Join. 40 sc .
7th rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each sc around. Join.
Rep last rnd until work from marked row measures 3 " $[7.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ]. Fasten off. Fold top $1 / 22^{\prime \prime}[1.25 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] to RS as seen in picture.
