



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 12" x 6½" [30.5 x16.5 cm].

GAUGE

16 sc and 19 rows = 4" [10 cm].



MATERIALS

Lily® Sugar'n Cream® (2.5 oz/70.9 g; 120 yds /109 m)

Main Color (MC) Hot Blue (01742)

1 ball or 57 yds/52 m

Contrast A Red (00095)

1 ball or 12 yds/11 m

Contrast B White (00001)

1 ball or 77 yds/70 m

Contrast C Hot Green (01712)

1 ball or 37 yds/34 m

Size U.S. F/5 (3.75 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Length of ribbon 18" [45.5 cm] long. Sewing needle and thread in coordinating shade.

INSTRUCTIONS

Stripe Pat

With MC, work 1 row.

With B, work 1 row.

With MC, work 1 row.

With A, work 2 rows.

With C, work 1 row.

With A, work 2 rows.

With MC, work 1 row.

With B, work 1 row.

With MC, work 4 rows.

These 14 rows form Stripe Pat.

With A, ch 49.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook.

1 sc in each ch to end of ch. 48 sc. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of

row. Turn.

Rep last row until work from beg

measures approx 3½" [9 cm], ending

on a RS row and joining MC at end of

last row. Break A.

Next row: (Fold row). (WS). With MC,

ch 1. *Working in front loops only*, 1 sc in

each sc to end of row. Turn.

Proceed in Stripe Pat as follows:

1st row: (RS). Ch 1. *Working in both*

loops, *1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Ch 1.

Skip next sc. 1 sc in each of next 10 sc.

Ch 1. Skip next sc. (1 sc in next sc. Ch 1.

Skip next sc) twice. 1 sc in each of next

5 sc. Rep from * once more. Join B.

Break MC. Turn.

2nd row: With B, ch 1. *1 sc in each of

next 5 sc. (Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in

next sc) twice. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc

in each of next 10 sc. Ch 1. Skip next sc.

1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Rep from *

once more. Turn.

First 2 rows of Stripe Pat complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, rep last

2 rows until 14 rows of Stripe Pat have

been completed twice. Fasten off.

Vertical Stripes

Stripe 1: With RS facing, join C with sl st

to unworked back loop only of 4th sc

of Fold row. Ch 28. Fasten off.



Weave ch through ch-1 sps, working over and under ch. Tie end of ch to last row to secure.

Stripe 2: Join A with sl st to unworked back loop only of 15th sc of Fold row. Work as for Stripe 1.

Stripe 3: Join C with sl st to unworked back loop only of 17th sc of Fold row. Work as for Stripe 1.

Stripe 4: Join A with sl st to unworked back loop only of 19th sc of Fold row. Work as for Stripe 1.

Stripe 5: Join C with sl st to unworked back loop only of 28th sc of Fold row. Work as for Stripe 1.

Stripe 6: Join A with sl st to unworked back loop only of 39th sc of Fold row. Work as for Stripe 1.

Stripe 7: Join C with sl st to unworked back loop only of 41st sc of Fold row. Work as for Stripe 1.

Stripe 8: Join A with sl st to unworked back loop only of 43rd sc of Fold row. Work as for Stripe 1.

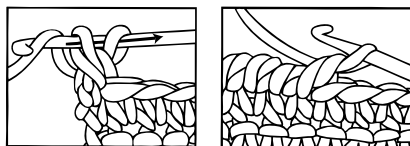
FINISHING

Edging: With WS facing, fold work at Fold row to form pocket. With RS facing, join B with sl st to top right corner of Caddy.

1st rnd: Ch 1. Work 1 rnd sc, working through both thicknesses where necessary, in rem back loops only along fold and working 3 sc in each corner. Join with sl st to first sc.

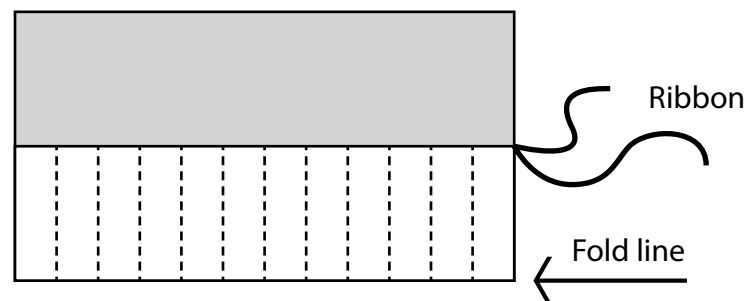
2nd rnd: Ch 1. Working from **left to right**, instead of from **right to left** as usual, work 1 reverse sc in each sc around. Join with sl st to first sc.

Fasten off.



Pocket divisions: With sewing thread, sew through all thicknesses from bottom to top of Pocket 4 sts in from side edge of work. Rep stitching at 4 st intervals along entire width of Pocket.

Tie: Mark length of ribbon approx 6" [15 cm] from one end. Sew ribbon at marker to outer end of Caddy as shown in photo, leaving long end of ribbon to wrap around Caddy.
