# **MATERIALS**

**Lily® Sugar'n Cream®** (2.5 oz/70.9 g; 120 yds/109 m)

Main Color (MC) Warm Brown (01130) 1 ball or 30 yds [28 m] Contrast A Wine (00015) 1 ball or 27 yds [25 m]

**Contrast B** Red (00095) **1 ball or 10 yds [9 m]** 

Size U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS:**

**Approx** = Approximate(ly)

**Cont** = Continue

**Dec** = Decrease(ing)

Inc = Increase(ing)

**K** = Knit

**Kfb** = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch

**K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches

together

Pat = Pattern

**Psso** = Pass slipped stitch over

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**SI** = Slip next stitch knitwise

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

#### **MEASUREMENT**

Approx 8" [20.5 cm] square.

#### **GAUGE**

20 sts and 26 rows = 4" [10 cm] stocking stitch.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

## **Stripe Pat**

With MC: 8 rows.

With A: 8 rows.

With B: 8 rows.

With A: 8 rows.

With MC: 8 rows.

These 40 rows form Stripe Pat.

With MC, cast on 43 sts.

Knit 6 rows (garter st), noting first row is RS and inc 2 sts evenly

across last row. 42 sts.

Proceed in Stripe Pat as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). K3. \*Kfb. K4. Sl1.

K2tog. psso. K4. Kfb. Rep from  $\ast$  to

last 3 sts. K3.

2nd row: K3. Purl to last 3 sts. K3.

3rd row: As 1st row.

4th row: Knit.

Last 4 rows form pat. First 4 rows

of Stripe Pat are complete.

Cont in pat as established until 40 rows of Stripe Pat have been completed, dec 2 sts evenly across last row of last rep. 40 sts. With A, knit 6 rows (garter st). Cast off.

## **Hanging Loop**

With MC, cast on 15 sts. Cast off. Fold Loop in half and sew to top left corner of Dish Cloth.
