



MATERIALS

Lily® Sugar'n Cream® (2.5 oz/70.9 g; 120 yds/109 m)
Main Color (MC) Country Yellow (01612) **1 ball or 55 yds/50 m**
Contrast A Black (00002) **1 ball or 3 yds/3 m**
Contrast B White (00001) **1 ball or 1 yd/1 m**

Size U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
 Pair of size U.S. 2 (2.75 mm) double-pointed knitting needles. Tapestry needle.

ABBREVIATIONS:

Approx = Approximate(ly)
Alt = Alternate(ing)
K = Knit
K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together
P = Purl
Rem = Remain(ing)

Rep = Repeat
RS = Right side
Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through the back loops together.

St(s) = Stitch(es)
Tog = Together
Yo = Yarn over
WS = Wrong side

KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

MEASUREMENTS
 Approx 7" x 9" [18 x 23 cm].

GAUGE
 20 sts and 26 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st on larger needles.

INSTRUCTIONS

Beehive
 With larger needles and MC, cast on 40 sts.
1st row: (RS). Purl.
2nd row: Knit.
3rd row: Purl.
4th and 5th rows: Rep 2nd and 3rd rows.
6th row: K1. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 38 sts.

7th row: Knit.
8th row: Purl.
9th and 10th rows: Rep 7th and 8th rows.
 Rep these 10 rows once more. 36 sts.

1st row: Purl.
2nd row: K1. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 36 sts.
3rd row: Purl.
4th row: Knit.
5th row: Purl.
6th row: As 2nd row. 34 sts.
7th row: Knit.
8th row: Purl.
9th and 10th rows: Rep 7th and 8th rows.
 Rep these 10 rows once more. 30 sts.



1st row: Purl.
2nd row: K1. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 28 sts.
3rd row: Purl.
4th row: As 2nd row. 26 sts.
5th row: Purl.
6th row: As 2nd row. 24 sts.
7th row: Knit.
8th row: Purl.
9th and 10th rows: Rep 7th and 8th rows.
11th row: Knit.
12th row: K1. (ssk) twice. Knit to last 5 sts. (K2tog) twice. K1. 20 sts.
13th row: Purl.
Rep 12th and 13th rows until 8 sts rem. Cast off knitwise (WS).

I-Cord Bees (make 2)

With pair of smaller needles and A, cast on 5 sts.

*K5. Slip sts to opposite end of needle.

Rep from * 6 times more, alt stripes of A and MC each row, ending last stripe with A. Break yarn and thread end through rem sts. Fasten securely.

Thread 6" [15 cm] length of B onto tapestry needle. Run yarn through center of Bee in a figure 8 shape to create wings and fasten securely. Sew Bees to Beehive.

Twisted Cord

Cut 2 lengths of MC 16" [40.5 cm] long. With both strands tog, hold one end with someone holding other end, twist strands to the right until they begin to curl. Fold the 2 ends tog and tie in a knot so they will not unravel. The strands will now twist themselves tog. Fold cord in half and secure ends at top of Beehive.
