



 KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

### MEASUREMENT

Approx 10" [25.5 cm] square.

### GAUGE

20 sts and 26 rows = 4" [10 cm]  
in stocking st.

### MATERIALS

Lily® Sugar'n Cream® (2.5 oz/70.9 g; 120 yds/109 m)

**Contrast A** Hot Blue (01742)      **1 ball or 52 yds/48 m**

**Contrast B** White (00001)      **1 ball or 52 yds/48 m**

Size U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

### INSTRUCTIONS

With A, cast on 53 sts.

Knit 4 rows (garter st), noting 1st row is WS.

**Next row:** (WS). K2. M1. K24. M1. K1. M1. K24. M1. K2. 57 sts.

Proceed in pat (multiple of 4 + 5) as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). With A, knit.

**2nd row:** K2. P1. \*Make Star. P1. Rep from \* to last 2 sts. K2.

**3rd row:** With B, knit.

**4th row:** K2. P3. Make Star. \*P1. Make Star. Rep from \* to last 5 sts. P3. K2.

These 4 rows form Striped Star St Pat.

Cont in pat until Dishcloth measures approx 9½" [24 cm] from cast on edge, ending on a 4th row.

**Next row:** (RS). With A, K2. K2tog. K20. K2tog. K5. K2tog. K20. K2tog. K2. 53 sts.

Knit 4 rows (garter st).  
Cast off loosely.

### ABBREVIATIONS:

**Approx** = Approximate(ly)

**Cont** = Continue

**K** = Knit

**K2tog** = Knit next 2 stitches together

**M1** = Make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch and knitting into back of loop.

**Make Star** = Purl next 3 stitches together leaving stitches on needle, yo, then purl same 3 stitches together again.

**P** = Purl

**Pat** = Pat

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**WS** = Wrong side
