VERTICAL STRIPES CROCHET DISHCLOTH



MATERIALS

Lily[®] Sugar'n Cream[®] (2.5 oz/70.9 g; 120 yds/109 m) Main Color (MC) Ecru (00004) 1 ball or 62 yds/57 m Contrast A Rose Pink (00046) or Stonewash (01118) or Meadow (01135) or Sunshine

(00073) or Blueberry (01725) or Orchid

(01137) **or** Robin's Egg (01215) **or** Warm

Brown (01130)

1 ball or 8.5 yds/8 m

Note: 1 ball each of MC and A will make 2 Dishcloths.

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Yarn needle.



CROCHET I SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately Beg = Beginning Ch = Chain(s) Rep = Repeat Sc = Single crochet Sl st = Slip stitch Sp(s) = Space(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es) **WS** = Wrong side

MEASUREMENT

Approx 8¹/₄" [21 cm] square.

GAUGE

13 sc and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

With MC, ch 28.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 2 ch. *Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 sc in each of next 4 ch. Rep from * to last 4 ch. Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 sc in each of last 3 ch. Turn. 27 sts.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 3 sc. *Ch 1. Skip next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Rep from * to last 4 sts. Ch 1. Skip next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in each of last 3 sc. Turn. Rep 2nd row until work from beg measures 8¹/₄" [21 cm]. Fasten off.

Vertical Surface SI St Rows:

Create vertical stripes by working sl st rows with A along ch-sp columns of Dishcloth as shown in photo.

With A, working from bottom to top edge, keeping yarn at back (WS) of work, surface sl st in each ch-1 sp of every row. Fasten off. Use yarn needle to darn in ends.
