



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: **BEGINNER**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx =
Approximately
Rep = Repeat
RS = Right side

Sl1Pwyif = Slip next
stitch purlwise, with
yarn in front of work
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Tog = Together

MEASUREMENT

Approximately (approx)
8" [20.5 cm] square.

GAUGE

8.5 stitches (sts) and 16 rows =
4" [10 cm] in garter stitch (st) with
4 strands held together (tog).

INSTRUCTIONS

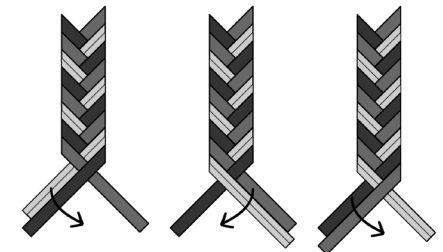
Note: Dishcloth is worked with
4 strands of yarn held together.
Divide single ball by pulling center
section out creating 2 approx
equal separate balls of yarn. Use
tail from inside and outside of
each ball to get 4 strands total.

DISHCLOTH

Using *long-tail cast on*, cast on
17 sts with 4 strands held tog.

1st row: [Right Side (RS)]. Slip
first st purlwise with yarn in front
(Sl1Pwyif). Knit to end of row.
Repeat (rep) last row until
Dishcloth measures 8" [20.5 cm].
Cast off, leaving a 10" [25.5 cm]
end for braided hanging loop.

Hanging loop: Braid the strands
together, holding two strands
together as one for 5" [12.5 cm].



MATERIALS

Lily® Sugar'n Cream® Super Size (Solids: 4 oz/113 g; 190 yds/174 m;
Ombres & Prints: 3 oz/85 g; 143 yds/131 m)

Indigo (18114)	1 ball or 126 yds/115 m
or Jade Mist (18813)	1 ball or 126 yds/115 m
or Jute (18082)	1 ball or 126 yds/115 m
or Sonoma (19512)	1 ball or 126 yds/115 m
or Bamboo (18807)	1 ball or 126 yds/115 m

Size U.S. 13 (9 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
Yarn needle.



Fasten braid with overhand knot with all four strands held together.



Fold braided portion in half and thread end of braid through top of last cast off st.
Weave in unbraided ends.
