



MOSAIC KNIT TABLE RUNNER | KNIT



MATERIALS

Lily® Sugar'n Cream® (2.5 oz/70.9 g; 120 yds/109 m)

Contrast A Overcast (01042) **5 balls or 540 yds/500 m**

Contrast B Soft Ecru (01004) 5 balls or 510 yds/465 m

Contrast C Seabreeze (01201) 3 balls or 250 yds/230 m

Size U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch markers.

KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 16" [40.5 cm] wide x 78" [198 cm] long.

GAUGE

20 sts and 26 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

With C, cast on 70 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows: Work 3 rows garter st (knit every row), noting first row is WS.

With A, knit 2 rows, inc 5 sts evenly across last row. 75 sts. Place marker at end of last row.

**Proceed in pat as follows:

1st row: (RS). With B, K3. *SI1Pyb. K3. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: With B, K3. *SI1Pyf. K3.

Rep from * to end of row.

3rd row: With A, K1. *Sl1Pyb. K3. Rep from * to last 2 sts. Sl1Pyb. K1.

4th row: With A, K1. *Sl1Pyf. K3. Rep from * to last 2 sts. Sl1Pyf.

K1.**

Rep these 4 rows for Three and One Pat until work from marked row measures approx 4" [10 cm], ending on a 4th row of pat.

With A, knit 2 rows.

With C, knit 2 rows.

With A, knit 2 rows.

With B, knit 2 rows, dec 3 sts evenly across last row. 72 sts.

Work Chart I to end of chart, reading RS rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right. These 40 rows form Mosaic Chart Pat.

Work a further 40 rows in Mosaic Chart Pat (80 rows total).

With A, knit 2 rows.
With C, knit 2 rows.
With A, knit 2 rows, inc 3 sts evenly across last row. 75 sts. Place a marker at end of last row.

Rep from ** to **.

Rep these 4 rows for Three and One Pat until work from <u>last marked</u> <u>row</u> measures approx 52" [132 cm], ending on a 4th row of pat.

With A, knit 2 rows.
With C, knit 2 rows.
With A, knit 2 rows.
With B, knit 2 rows, dec 3 sts evenly across last row. 72 sts.

Work Chart I to end of chart, reading RS rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right.
These 40 rows form Mosaic Chart Pat.

Work a further 40 rows in Mosaic Chart Pat (80 rows total).

With A, knit 2 rows.
With C, knit 2 rows.
With A, knit 2 rows, inc 3 sts evenly across last row. 75 sts. Place a marker at end of last row.

Rep from ** to **.
Rep these 4 rows for Three and One
Pat until work <u>from last marked</u>
<u>row</u> measures approx 4" [10 cm],
ending on a 4th row of pat.

With A, knit 2 rows, dec 5 sts evenly across first row. 70 sts.
With C, knit 3 rows.
Cast off knitways (WS).

Side edging: With RS facing and C, pick up and knit 335 sts evenly across side edge of Runner. Knit 2 rows. Cast off knitwise (WS). Rep along opposite side edge.

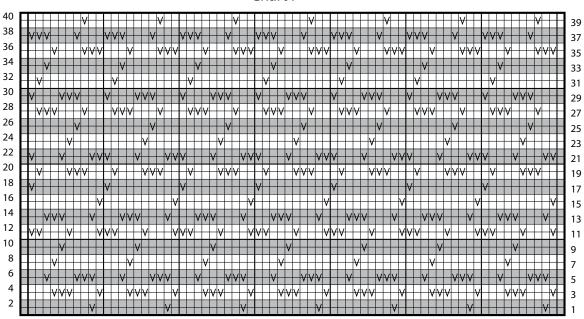
 \square = With A, knit.
