

## MATERIALS

Lily ${ }^{\circledR}$ Sugar'n Cream ${ }^{\circledR}$ (2.5 oz/70.9 g; 120 yds/109 m)

Contrast A Yellow (00010)
Contrast B Beach Glass (01132)
Contrast C Tea Rose (00042)
Contrast D Stonewash (01118)

1 ball or $\mathbf{3 0} \mathbf{y d s} / \mathbf{2 7} \mathbf{~ m}$ 1 ball or $80 \mathrm{yds} / 73 \mathrm{~m}$ 1 ball or $60 \mathrm{yds} / 55 \mathrm{~m}$ 1 ball or $80 \mathrm{yds} / 73 \mathrm{~m}$ Size U.S. $7(4.5 \mathrm{~mm})$ crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Black embroidery thread for mouth. Two safety eyes $3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ [ 1 cm ] diameter (or buttons). Embroidery needle. Tapestry needle. $11 " \times 22 "$ [ $28 \times 56 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] cardboard for backing (optional). Spray adhesive (optional).

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 101/2" x 211/2" [26.5 x 54.5 cm ], excluding fringe.

## GAUGE

14 sc and 15 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ].

## INSTRUCTIONS

## Stripe Pat

Work 10 rows of each color in following sequence: $A, B, C, D$.

With A, ch 2.
1st row: (RS). 7 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Turn. 7 sc .
2nd row: Ch 1. ${ }^{* 1}$ sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 sc in next sc. Turn. 10 sc .
3rd row: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. 13 sc .

4th row: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 3 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. 16 sc . 5th row: Ch 1. ${ }^{*} 1$ sc in each of next 4 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. 19 sc . 6th row: Ch $1 .{ }^{*} 1$ sc in each of next 5 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. 22 sc . 7th row: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 6 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. 25 sc . 8th row: Ch $1 .{ }^{*} 1$ sc in each of next 7 sc. 2 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. 28 sc . 9th row: Ch 1. ${ }^{*} 1$ sc in each of next 8 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. 31 sc . 10th row: Ch 1. *1 sc in each of next 9 sc .2 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. 34 sc . First 10 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, cont as established inc 3 sts every row until Stripe Pat is complete. Fasten off. 124 sc.

## FINISHING

## Fringe

Cut strands of $A, B, C$ and $D 8^{\prime \prime}$ [ 20.5 cm ] long. Taking 2 strands tog, fold in half and knot into fringe along bottom edge of Wall Hanging (see picture for placement). Trim fringe evenly.


## Face

Attach Safety Eyes as shown in picture. With Black embroidery thread, embroider mouth as shown in picture.

Optional: Trace Wall Hanging (excluding fringe) onto cardboard and cut out. With spray adhesive, glue cardboard to WS of Wall Hanging.
