



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

- Alt** = Alternate
- Approx** = Approximately
- Beg** = Beginning
- K1fb** = Increase 1 stitc by knitting into fnt and back of next stitch.
- Rep** = Repeat
- RS** = Right side
- Sl1P** = Slip next stitch purlwise

- Sl1Pwyif** = Slip next stitch purlwise with yarn at front of work
- St(s)** = Stitch(es)
- Tog** = Together
- Yb** = Take yarn to back of work
- Yf** = Take yarn to front of work

MEASUREMENT

Approx 9" [23 cm] square.

GAUGE

20 sts and 26 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Pattern creates double-sided fabric. At the end of work both sides need to be separated by slipping every alt stitch on a spare needle.

Cast on 40 sts loosely.

1st row: (RS). Sl1P. *K1fb. Rep from * to last st. K1.

2nd row: Sl1P. *K1. Sl1Pwyif. Rep from * to last st. K1.

Rep 2nd row until work from beg measures 7" [18 cm].

Next row: Sl1P. *K1. yf. Slip next st to a spare needle. yb. K1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

Sides are separated. Sts are divided as 40 sts on working needle and 38 sts on a spare needle.

Cast off 38 sts from spare needle. Slip 40 sts from right-hand working needle onto left-hand working needle to change direction of knitting. Cast off 40 sts from working needle.

FINISHING

Following diagram on page 2, fold Pot Holder flat and sew cast off edges tog.

MATERIALS

Lily® Sugar'n Cream® Scrub off™ (2.6 oz/75 g; 106 yds/97 m)

Version 1: Greens (90015) **1 ball or 106 yds/97 m**

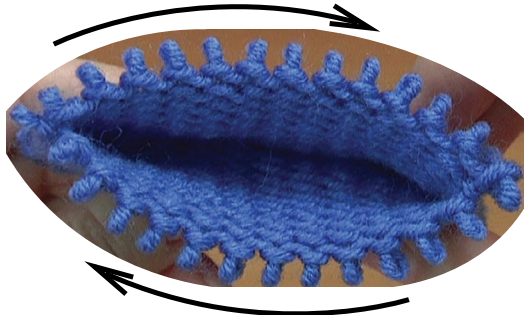
Version 2: Spring Blue (90016) **1 ball or 106 yds/97 m**

Version 3: Papaya (90014) **1 ball or 106 yds/97 m**

Size U.S. 6 (4 mm) Susan Bates® knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Size U.S. 6 (4 mm) Susan Bates® spare knitting needle. Susan Bates® yarn needle.

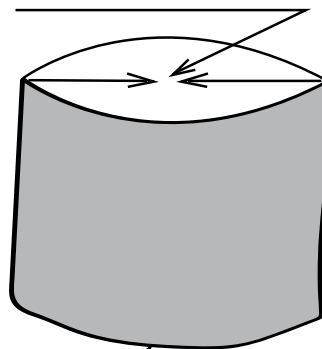


Cast off sts from spare needle

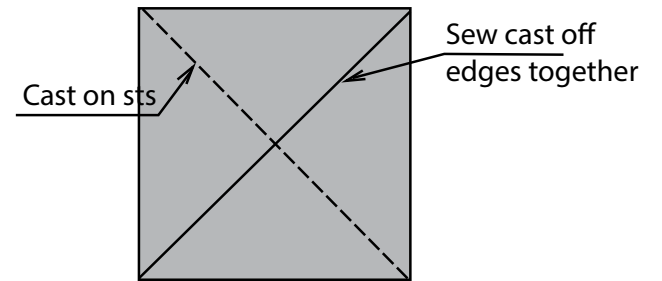


Cast off sts from left-hand needle

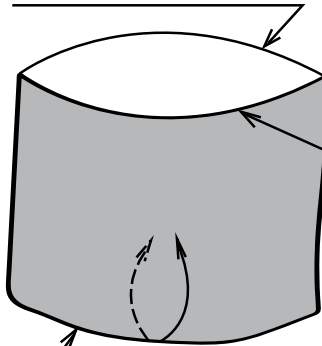
and sew cast off edges flat in perpendicular direction to cast-on edge
