

MATERIALS
Lily ${ }^{\circledR}$ Sugar'n Cream ${ }^{\circledR}$ (2.5 oz/70.9 g; 120 yds/109 m)
Contrast A Warm Brown (01130) 2 balls
Contrast B Ecru (00004)
Contrast C Sage Green (00084)
1 ball

Contrast D Hot Purple (01317)
1 ball

Contrast E Tea Rose (00042)
1 ball

Sizes U.S. 5 ( 3.75 mm ) and U.S. $7(4.5 \mathrm{~mm}$ ) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. Cable needle.


## ABBREVIATIONS

Alt = Alternate(ing)
Approx = Approximate(ly)
C6F = Slip next 3 stitches onto cable needle and leave at front of work. K3, then K3 from cable needle.
Inc = Increasing
$\mathbf{K}=$ Knit
K2tog = Knit 2 stitches together $\mathbf{P}=$ Purl
Pat = Pattern
Psso = Pass slipped stitch over
Rem = Remain(ing)
Rep $=$ Repeat
RS $=$ Right side
SI1 = Slip next stitch knitwise
Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together.
St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS = Wrong side

## SIZE

To fit 6 cup tea pot.

## GAUGE

20 sts and 26 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] with larger needles in stocking st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Back and Front: (make 2 pieces alike) With A and larger needles, cast on 35 sts.
1st row: (WS). Knit.
2nd row: Knit.
3rd row: *K3. P5. Rep from * to last 3 sts. K3.
4th row: *P3. K5. Rep from * to last 3 sts. P3.

5th row: As 3rd row. 6th row: Knit.
7th row: P4. *K3. P5. Rep from * to last 7 sts. K3. P4.
8th row: K4. *P3. K5. Rep from * to last 7 sts. P3. K4.
9th row: As 7th row.
10th row: Knit.
Rep 3rd to 10th rows for pat until work from beg measures approx 5 " [12.5 cm ], ending on a 10th row of pat.
Knit 5 rows (garter st). Break A. With B, beg with a knit row, work 6 rows in stocking st.
Next row: (RS). *K2. K2tog. Rep from * to last 3 sts. K3. 27 sts.

## 'Zarnspirations" <br> spark your inspiration!

Work 3 rows even in stocking st.
Next row: *K1. K2tog. Rep from * to end of row. 18 sts.
Next row: Purl.
Next row: (K2tog) 9 times. Break yarn leaving a long end. Draw end tightly through rem 9 sts.

Handle: With A and larger needles, cast on 8 sts.
1st row: (RS). K8.
2nd and alt rows: K1. P6. K1.
3rd row: K1. C6F. K1.
5th row: K8.
6th row: As 2nd row.
Rep these 6 rows until Handle measures approx $91 / 2$ " [ 24 cm ], ending on a 4th row of pat. Cast off.

## Leaf: (make 10).

With C and smaller needles, cast on 2 sts.
Knit 3 rows, noting first row is WS. Proceed in pat as follows:
1st row: (RS). Inc 1 st in first st. K1. 3 sts.
2nd and alt rows: Purl
3rd row: (K1. yo) twice. K1. 5 sts.
5th row: K2. yo. K1. yo. K2. 7 sts.
7th row: K3. yo. K1. yo. K3. 9 sts.
9th row: K1. K2tog. K3. ssk. K1.
7 sts.
11th row: K1.K2tog. K1.ssk. K1.5 sts.

13th row: K1. SI1. K2tog. psso. K1. 3 sts.
15th row: SI1. K2tog. psso. Fasten off.

Flower: (make 2 with D and 3 with E). With larger needles cast on 50 sts. K1. *Cast off 7 sts, leaving rem st on right-hand needle. Rep from * 6 times more. 8 sts on righthand needle. Break yarn leaving a long end. Draw end tightly through rem 8 sts for center of Flower. Arrange 'petals' evenly around center.

## FINISHING

Sew sides of Front and Back tog, leaving 5" [12.5 cm] openings for spout or handle. Sew Leaves and Flowers in position to $B$ section at top of Tea Cozy as shown in photo. Sew Handle in position.
