GENERAL INFORMATION			
1. Unlimited re-entries available through the close of registration (start of level 10)			
2. Blind levels on Day 1 will be 40 minutes, Day 2 & Day 3 will be 60 minutes, Heads Up will be 30 minutes.			
3. Day 1 flights will play down to 12.5% of the field. Day 2 players will be in the money.			
4. Players who bag more than once, will have their biggest bag move forwards and will get a minimum cash on day 2 for each bag removed from play.			
5. There will be a redraw at the end of Day 1, and the final 27, 18, and 9 players. Day 2 will play down to the final 6 players.			

Blinds will be raised until the completion of the tournament.

Buy-in is \$1,350 to the prize pool and \$150 tournament access fee · Players may re-enter through the dinner break, players will have an option to forfeit their current chip stack up to the start of level 10 · A single ante will be paid from the big blind for each hand · The ante is paid after the big blind · The ante will not reduce · Day 2 and 3 will be 60 minute levels and will start at the best possible level, with breaks every 2 levels · The final 6 will be streamed.
