Tournament Rules

- 1. Players will start this event with 25,000 tournament chips.
- 2. Color of chip denominations: Black = 100, Blue = 500, Orange = 1,000, Red = 5,000, Yellow = 25,000, Pink = 100,000
- 3. \$1,000 Buy-in = \$870 prize pool + \$100 administrative fee + \$30 staffing fee
- 4. Registration and unlimited re-entries are available until the start of Level 9. Eliminated players may reenter until this time at the registration counter. All original fees apply.
- 5. This tournament is scheduled for one day. The tournament director in their sole and absolute discretion may adjust the break schedule, the start and stop time, the level lengths, and/or add additional day(s) if necessary. If the event has not concluded by 2:30am, players have 15 minutes to discuss a deal or they must bag their chips and return for Day 2 the following day at 3pm.
- 6. Blind Levels will be 30 Minutes long.
- 7. Players may only forfeit a short stack during the close of registration break to re-enter with a full stack.
- 8. Alternates and late registration players will start will a full starting stack.
- 9. A single ante will be paid from the big blind for the entire table.
- 10. The big blind is posted first.
- 11. Players will receive a break approx. every two hours.
- 12. A redraw will also occur with 18 and 9 players or at Tournament Supervisor's discretion.
- 13. Management reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel this tournament.
- 14. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors and/or misinformation on any website (including third parties) or any printed material pertaining to this event. Players will have no claim or recourse in these matters.
- 15. In the spirit of TDA Rule #1, it is each and every player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
- 16. Winners must show valid identification to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to IRS regulations; W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buyin).
