1. Players will start this event with 25,000 tournament chips.
2. Color of chip denominations: Black $=100$, Blue $=500$, Orange $=1,000$, Red $=5,000$, Yellow $=25,000$, Pink $=100,000$ 3. $\$ 300$ Buy-in $=\$ 150$ prize pool $+\$ 100$ player bounty + $\$ 35$ administrative fee $+\$ 15$ staffing fee
3. Bounties are always included when calculating the total prize pool for purposes of determining the guarantee.
4. When a player is eliminated, half of the eliminated player's bounty is awarded to the eliminator and the other half is added to the eliminator's bounty. All bounties will be distributed in $\$ 25$ increments. When rounding is needed, paying bounty to the player will be the priority and adding to the progressive bounty will be secondary. When an all-in player is eliminated by 2 or more players, those players chop the bounty and any $\$ 25$ increments that cannot be chopped will be awarded in order of action.
5. Registration and unlimited re-entries are available until the start of Level 9 . Eliminated players may re-enter until this time at the registration counter. All original fees apply.
6. This event is a bounty tournament and scheduled for one day. The tournament director in their sole and absolute discretion may adjust the break schedule, the start and stop time, the level lengths, and/or add additional day(s) if necessary. If the event has not concluded by 2:30am, players have 15 minutes to discuss a deal or they must bag their chips and return for Day 2 the following day at 3 pm .
7. Blind Levels will be 30 Minutes long.
8. Players may only forfeit a short stack during the close of registration break to re-enter with a full stack.
9. Alternates and late registration players will start will a full starting stack.
10. A single ante will be paid from the big blind for the entire table. The big blind is posted first.
11. Players will receive a break approx. every two hours.
12. A redraw will also occur with 18 and 9 players or at Tournament Supervisor's discretion.
13. Management reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel this tournament.
14. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors and/or misinformation on any website (including third parties) or any printed material pertaining to this event. Players will have no claim or recourse in these matters.
